JUDGMENT IN A CIVIL CASE

JURY VERDICT. This action came before the Court for a trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury has rendered its verdict as follows:

In favor of defendant Robert Wilson and against the plaintiff.

In favor of the plaintiff and against defendant Terry Rogers in the amount of \$15,000 compensatory damages and \$20,000 punitive damages.

In favor of plaintiff and against the defendant Dee Burgin in the amount of \$15,000 compensatory damages and \$20,000 punitive damages.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that pursuant to a finding of qualified immunity, judgment is entered in favor of defendant Beverly Weger and against the plaintiff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that pursuant to Rule 50(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, judgment is entered in favor of defendant County of Edgar, Illinois, and against the plaintiff. Plaintiff offered no evidence that the County of Edgar, Illinois, violated plaintiff's constitutional rights. Also, defendant County of Edgar, Illinois, was not a necessary party in this case because all other defendants were sued in their individual capacity. See Askew v. Sheriff of Cook County, 568 F.3d 632, 637 (7th Cir. 2009).
