



This cause having come forth on the request of Rob Scales, Assistant States Attorney of Coles County, for the forfeiture of the following described properties to the Coles County Sheriff's Office;

That certain items of evidence were seized as evidence previously herein, being:

One (1) 9mm Helwan Pistol with empty magazine Serial number 1164424, one (1) paper fold with residue, one (1) 22 caliber shell casing, eight (8) 9mm rounds, and one (1) 9mm magazine with 7 rounds

And the Court having found that disposition has been reached in the above entitled cause; the confiscated properties are no longer needed for evidentiary purposes, and no legitimate claim has been made for such properties.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND DECREED that said properties are forfeited to the Coles County Sheriff's Office, who shall proceed to dispose of them in accordance with Department policy.
