COMPLAINT FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

Now comes Plaintiff, Mr. John Kraft, pro se, who prays this Court render a declaratory judgment and grant injunctive relief under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq. For this Complaint states as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff John Kraft. The plaintiff is an Illinois resident, and resides in the County of Edgar.
- 2. Defendant is the Township of Arcola, a public body as that term is defined in 5 ILCS 140/2(a).
- 3. On May 4, 2014, Plaintiff served a FOIA request on Defendant office of Arcola Township seeking copies of public records. A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

- 4. On May 22, 2014, Plaintiff sent two emails to
 Defendant's FOIA Officer. The first email asking if they
 (Defendant) intended on responding to the May 4, 2014 request or
 if he needed to file another civil suit. Defendant responded
 stating that they sent the FOIA request to their attorney, Mr.
 Petty, and that they believed he sent a response. Plaintiff sent
 a second email informing Defendant that Mr. Petty did not
 respond and asked them, for the third time, to please respond to
 the FOIA request. A true and correct copy of the correspondence
 is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B.
- 5. On May 23, 2014, Defendant responded informing Plaintiff that Mark Petty may have responded to your [Plaintiff's] attorney. Plaintiff then responded stating that He did not have an attorney for anything other than that one court case, and asked for a fourth time for Defendant to respond to the FOIA request. A true and correct copy of the correspondence is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B.
- 6. As of June 2, 2014, Defendant has never responded to the May 4, 2014 Freedom Of Information Act request.
- 7. Section 11(a) of the Illinois Freedom Of Information

 Act [5 ILCS 140/11(a)] provides that: "Any person denied access

 to inspect or copy any public record by a public body may file

 suit for injunctive or declaratory relief."

8. Pursuant to Section 11(h) of the Act [5 ILCS 140/11(h)] Plaintiff is requesting that these proceedings take precedence on the docket over all other causes, except those causes the court considers to be of greater importance, and be assigned a hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way.

COUNT ONE

(Violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.)

- 9. Plaintiff reaffirms paragraphs 1 8 as though fully restated herein.
- 10. Plaintiff is being denied his legal right to inspect public records by Defendant failure to produce the records requested on May 4, 2014.
 - 11. Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law.

COUNT TWO

(Violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.)

12. Plaintiff reaffirms paragraphs 1 - 8 as though fully restated herein.

- 13. Defendant improperly denied the FOIA request by their failure properly respond in accordance with 5 ILCS 140/3 and 5 ILCS 140/9.
 - 14. Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays this Court:

- A. Declare Defendant to be in violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.; and
- B. Enjoin the Defendant from continuing to withhold access to any and all non-exempt public records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA request and further enjoin Defendant to provide copies of any and all records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA requests without further delay; and
- C. Enjoin the Defendant to prepare, forthwith, an affidavit declaring that they will provide complete access to Plaintiff and further declaring that any and all non-exempt public records responsive to the request will be made available to Plaintiff; and
- D. Order Defendant to prepare, forthwith, an affidavit identifying with specificity any and all public records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA request that are claimed to be subject to legal exemption from disclosure and further identifying with specificity the reason(s) for any such claim of exemption; and

- E. Declare Defendant acted willfully, intentionally, and in bad faith in the failure to respond to and to provide responsive documents to Plaintiff's FOIA request; and
- F. Order Defendant to pay a civil penalty of not less than \$2,500 nor more than \$5,000 for each occurrence, as outlined in 5 ILCS 140/11(j) as the Court finds just and equitable; and
- G. Award Plaintiff reasonable fees, including attorney fees if Plaintiff should retain the services of an attorney, and all costs/fees incurred in litigating this suit as the Court finds just and equitable.
