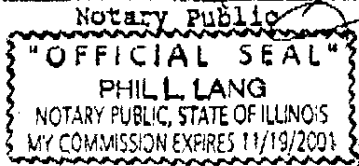

Mrs. Henry said that her husband John then awoke due to the noise. She said her husband John then got out of bed and Mr. Kaye began yelling at him, about owing money for trash collection. Mrs. Henry then observed Mr. Kaye strike her husband John on the stomach and one other time but she could not tell where Mr. Kaye hit Mr. Henry. Mrs. Henry continued yelling at Mr. Kaye demanding that he leave. Mrs. Henry then stated that Mr. Kaye then left her residence through the front door. Mrs. Henry said Mr. Kaye then got into a Maroon Pick-up truck License 9573LG with an unidentified white male and left the residence. Mrs. Henry stated she did wish to press charges against Mr. Kaye. Statements were also taken from her husband John and son. Assisted by Deputy McFarland of the Cumberland Co. Sheriff's Office. Mr. Kaye was located at his residence 1096 E. Co. Rd. 1200N-Toledo. Mr. Kaye after being read his Miranda warning verbatim admitted to being at the Henry residence but, would not elaborate on the incident, stating he did not go into their house. Mr. Kaye was then placed under arrest. Mr. Kaye refused to go to the Coles County Sheriff's Office and insisted on going to the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Kaye was then placed into the Cumberland County unit and brought back to the Henry residence in Jamesville for the purpose of obtaining a positive identification by the Henry family. Once at the Henry residence both Margaret and John Henry positively identified Mr. Kaye as the suspect. Mr. Kaye was then transported to Cumberland County Sheriff's Dept. by Cumberland County Sheriff's Department.

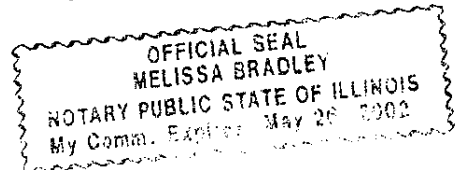

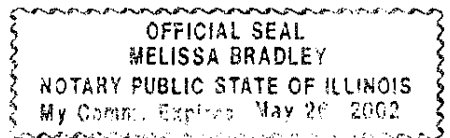

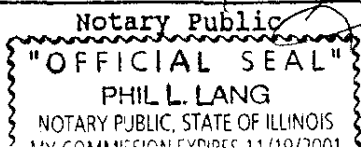

Now on this June 8, 2000, this cause comes on for hearing on Defendant's application for Probation and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that it has jurisdiction of the subject matter thereof and of all parties hereto and that the Defendant should be admitted to Probation.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that the Defendant be, and s/he is hereby placed on Probation for a period of two (2) years from and after this date, subject to the following conditions:

1. That the Defendant shall not violate any criminal statute of any jurisdiction.
2. That the Defendant shall not leave the State of Illinois without the prior consent of the Court.
3. That the Defendant shall not leave the County of Coles without the prior permission of his/her Probation Officer, except for the pursuit of his/her employment.
4. That the Defendant shall make a report to his/her Probation Officer of this Court, or to such other person or agency as directed by his/her Probation Officer, at such times as directed by his/her Probation Officer.
5. That the Defendant shall permit his/her Probation Officer to visit his/her place of residence and/or employment as his/her Probation Officer deems necessary.
6. That the Defendant shall keep his/her Probation Officer advised of his/her place of residence and employment at all times, advising the Probation Officer prior to any change of residence or employment.
7. That the Defendant shall support his/her legal dependents.

8. That the Defendant shall not possess a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
9. That the Defendant shall be employed full time, attend school or vocational training, or the Defendant shall perform up to forty (40) hours of Public Service Employment per week.
10. That the Defendant shall appear in Court at 9:00 a.m. on **August 3, 2000**, and thereafter as ordered by the Court or his/her Probation Officer, for a Proof of Progress hearing.
11. That the Defendant shall submit to a search of his/her person, residence, or automobile at any time as directed by his/her Probation Officer to verify compliance with the conditions of this Probation Order.
12. That the Defendant shall perform **zero (0) hours** of Public Service Employment during his/her term of Probation as designated by his/her Probation Officer.
13. That the Defendant shall provide evidence of income, assets, and liabilities upon request from his/her Probation Officer.
14. That the Defendant shall pay a monthly fee of **\$25.00** for each month of Probation Supervision ordered by the Court. Said fee shall be paid on or before the last day of each month. The Defendant shall immediately notify his/her Probation Officer of any change in marital status, or number of legal dependents.
15. That the Defendant shall not have in his/her body the presence of any illicit drug prohibited by the Cannabis Control Act or the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, unless prescribed by a physician, and shall submit samples of his/her blood or urine or both for tests to determine the presence of any illicit drug, and the Defendant shall pay all costs for said testing.
16. That the Defendant shall be eligible for participation in the Administrative Sanctions Program as adopted by the Chief Judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit for any technical violation of the terms and conditions of this Order.
17. That the Defendant shall pay **Fine and Court Costs** in the amount of **\$1,500.00 in each of the three (3) counts for a total of \$4,500.00** in Equal Monthly Installments during his/her term of Probation.
