RE: Response to Freedom of Information Act Requests
Request Date: April 26, 2017

Dear Mr. Turley:

The City of Carlinville is in receipt of your FOIA Requests dated April 26, 2017 (the "FOIA Request"), and received by the City on April 27, 2017. It was forwarded to me by the FOIA Officer for reply.

The first FOIA Request is for one item:

1. A copy of the same data CD that was requested by John Kraft on March 20, 2017 (this should include copy of all agreements, contracts, etc. between the City of Carlinville (to include its Police Department) and Blackburn College.)

The City is denying your request in full for the following reasons:

1. No data CD was provided in response to a request by John Kraft on March 20, 2017.
2. No "agreements, contracts, etc." between the City of Carlinville and Blackburn College, including the Carlinville Police Department exist. Therefore, there are no documents which are responsive to your request.

The second FOIA Request is for four items:

1. A copy of the same data CD that was requested by John Kraft on March 18, 2017.
2. Copy of all credit card, debit card, fuel charge card, p-card, purchase card statements (all pages) since October 1, 2016.
3. Copy of all cell/smart phone statements (all pages) since October 1, 2016.



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4. Copy of Open Meetings Act and Freedom Of Information Act proofs of training for all elected officials of the City of Carlinville.

The City is denying your request in part and granting it in part for the following reasons:

1. No data CD was provided in response to a request by John Kraft on March 20, 2017.
2. Items 2, 3 & 4 are enclosed with this letter in the same form as provided to Mr. Kraft in response to his request of March 20, 2017.

You have the right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a)) You may file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within sixty (60) calendar days of the date of this denial letter. (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a)) You must include a copy of your original FOIA Request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review.

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court.
