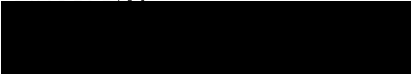

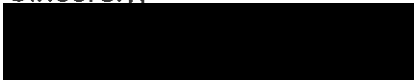

Any candidate for election, appointment, or contract to the office of township assessor or multi-township assessor must obtain certification from the Illinois Department of Revenue stating that they have met educational requirements prior to becoming a candidate or being appointed or contracted to office.

If the candidate has completed their educational requirements since the election and provides a Certificate of Educational Qualification from the Department, the township or multi-township assessment district may choose to appoint the individual to office pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/2-60.
