During flu season, my daughter was sick with the flu virus and was put on a round of Tamiflu for her symptoms by her personal physician. I also received a prescription for Tamiflu as a prophylactic medicine from the physician who is also my personal. Both medications were filled at IMH.

My daughter had a severe case of the flu and she had started vomiting 48hrs after starting the medication. I spoke with our Infectious Disease Nurse inquiring if the vomiting could be a result of the medication or could possibly be part of the flu virus.

At that time she inquired if I was taking Tamiflu and I told her I got some from the doctor. She told me I could have Tamiflu from the FIPHD stock, as it was no longer useable to give out to the public and was just going to go to waste; I could have used it for my family. I stated my husband did not get a round as he has a different doctor. I received a round of Tamiflu for my husband from FIPHD. However, I cannot remember who gave it to me. I felt reassured by my conversation with the infectious disease nurse that this was okay to do. Mr. Corbett did not tell me this; the Infectious disease nurse did.
