COMPLAINT FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

NOW COMES THE PLAINTIFF, Mr. Kirk Allen, pro se, and prays this Court render a declaratory judgment and grant an injunctive relief under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq. For this complaint states as follows.

- 1. Plaintiff Kirk Allen, is an Illinois resident, and resides in the County of Edgar.
- Defendants are the Illinois State Health & Family Services, a public body as that term is defined by 5 ILCS 140/2(a), and Julie Hamos, in her official capacity as the Director of Health & Family Services.

- 3. This court has jurisdiction as outlined in the Illinois Freedom of Information Act 5 ILCS 140/11(b)
- 4. On September 27, 2013, Plaintiff served a FOIA request on Defendant office of Illinois Health & Family Services, seeking copies of public records that included, among others:
 - 1. Copy of the Resume's for the 13 people working on the MMIS project.
 - 2. Names of the 13 people working on the MMIS project.
 - 3. Copy of all emails sent from any HFS employee and/or executive to the Huffington Post in the last two weeks.
 - 4. Copy of all e-mails sent by any HFS employee and/or executive to Matt Brown,
 Chief Procurement Officer, or any other employee from the Procurement office in the
 last 12 months.
 - 5. Copy of all e-mails received by any HFS employee and/or executive from Matt Brown, Chief Procurement Officer, or any other employee from the Procurement Office in the last 12 months.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

5. On October 3, 2013, Defendant responded by e-mail requesting additional clarification to Plaintiff's request.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B.

6. On October 3, 2013, Plaintiff responded to Defendant's request for additional clarification as requested by Defendant.

7. On October 7, 2013, Defendant provided a partial response to Plaintiff 's request for records and invoked an additional 5days to respond to items #3-5 of the original request.

8. On October 15, 2013, Defendants responded citing no records for item #3 of the Plaintiffs' request and a request for an extension of time to October 22, 2013 in order to provide the remaining requested documentation for items #4 and #5 of the original request.

9. On October 15, 2013, Plaintiff responded to Defendant with a written agreement to extend the timeline for a response for records to October 22, 2013.

10. On October 15, 2013, Plaintiff requested clarification regarding Defendant's response (exhibit E) and indications that CMS actually did the search for requested records.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit G.

11. On October 16, 2013, Plaintiff requested a copy of the request Defendant sent to Central Management Services (CMS) and their response to that request.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit H.

12. On October 16, 2013, Defendant responded with the requested information outlined in Plaintiff Exhibit H.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit I.

13. On October 17, 2013, Plaintiff revised its request as it pertained to item #3 of the original FOIA request outlined in Exhibit A.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit J.

14. On October 17, 2013, Defendant responded with confirmation of the revised request for item #3 of the original FOIA request outlined in Exhibit A.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit K.

15. On October 23, 2013, Defendants responded with the remaining items subject to the agreed extension of October 22, 1013, which were items #4 and #5 of the original FOIA request outlined in Exhibit A.

A true and correct copy of the request is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit L.

16. Section 2(c) of the FOIA [5 ILCS 140/2(c)] defines "Public records" as:

"Public records" means all records, reports, forms, writings, letters, memoranda, books, papers,
maps, photographs, microfilms, cards, tapes, recordings, electronic data processing records,
electronic communications, recorded information and all other documentary materials pertaining
to the transaction of public business, regardless of physical form or characteristics, having been
prepared by or for, or having been or being used by, received by, in the possession of, or under the
control of any public body.

17. Section 2.5 of the FOIA [5 ILCS 140/2.5] provides that:

"All records relating to the obligation, receipt, and use of public funds of the State, units of local government, and school districts are public records subject to inspection and copying by the public".

18. Pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Act [5 ILCS 140/7(2)]:

"A public record that is not in the possession of a public body but is in the possession of a party with whom the agency has contracted to perform a governmental function on behalf of the public body, and that directly relates to the governmental function and is not otherwise exempt under this Act, shall be considered a public record of the public body, for purposes of this Act".

- 19. Section 11(a) of the Act [5 ILCS 140/11(a)] provides that:

 "Any person denied access to inspect or copy any public record by a public body may file suit for injunctive or declaratory relief."
- 20. Pursuant to Section 11(h) of the Act [5 ILCS 140/11(h)], Plaintiff requests that these proceedings take precedence on the docket over all other causes, except those cases the court considers to be of greater importance, and be assigned a hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way.

COUNT ONE

(Violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.)

21. Plaintiff reaffirms paragraphs 1-20 as though fully restated herein.

- 22. Plaintiff is being denied his legal right to inspect public records by Defendants failure to produce the records requested on September 27, 2013. See Exhibit A.
 - 23. Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law.

COUNT TWO

(Violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.)

- 24. Plaintiff reaffirms paragraphs 1-20 as though fully restated herein.
- 25. Defendant improperly denied the request in Count One of this Complaint by their failure to follow 5 ILCS 140/3 and 5 ILCS140/9.
 - 26. Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law.

WHERFORE, Plaintiff prays this Court:

- A. Declare Defendants to be in violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq.; and
- B. Enjoin the Defendants from continuing to withhold access to any and all non-exempt public records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA requests and further enjoin Defendants to provide copies of any and all records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA requests without further delay; and
- C. Enjoin the Defendants to prepare, forthwith, an affidavit declaring that they will provide complete access to Plaintiff and further declaring that any and all non-exempt public records responsive to the request will be made available to Plaintiff; and
- D. Order Defendants to prepare, forthwith, an affidavit identifying with specificity any and all public records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA requests that are claimed to be subject to legal exemption from disclosure and further identifying with specificity the reason(s) for any such claim of exemption; and

- E. Declare Defendants acted willfully, intentionally, and in bad faith in failing to properly deny and in failing to provide responsive documents to Plaintiff's FOIA requests; and
- F. Order Defendants to pay a civil penalty of not less than \$2,500 nor more than \$5,000 for each occurrence, as outlined in 5 ILCS 140/11(j) as the Court finds just and equitable; and
- G. Award Plaintiff reasonable fees, and all costs/fees incurred in filing this suit as the Court finds just and equitable.

Thank you for writing to the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

The FOIA Office received your FOIA request on September 30, 2013 for the following information:

- 5. Copy of all e-mails received by any HFS employee and/or executive from Matt Brown, Chief Procurement Officer, or any other employee from the Procurement Office in the last 12 months.

The Department responded to items 1 and 2 of your request on October 7, 2013.

The Department responded to item 3 of your request on October 15, 2013.

On October 3, 2013, you narrowed your request for items 4 and 5 to include only emails between HFS employees and Matt Brown, rather than emails between HFS employees and any employee from the Procurement office.

The Department is not capable of performing a search of all employees' email accounts, so Department staff made a request to the Department of Central Management Services (CMS) to perform the search. CMS provided HFS staff with 245 electronic communications. Attached are the responsive results from that search — emails between HFS employees and Matt Brown. Most of the documents provided by CMS were not responsive to your request, and are therefore not included. Non-responsive communications include: outlook calendar appointment notices and emails that were not between Matt Brown and HFS employees (i.e., some emails were from IDOC, DNR, ISP or OHIT employees, to name a few, or other employees from the EEC. HFS staff are unclear why these emails were produced from CMS' search).

Some responsive emails have been withheld pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA as they as "preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated." The emails that are being withheld contain opinions and expressions regarding formulating policies and/or decisions, and are therefore exempt from disclosure.

Section 7(1)(f) provides in pertinent part:

- (1) When a request is made to inspect or copy a public record that contains information that is exempt from disclosure under this Section, but also contains information that is not exempt from disclosure, the public body may elect to redact the information that is exempt. The public body shall make the remaining information available for inspection and copying. Subject to this requirement, the following shall be exempt from inspection and copying:
 - (f) Preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.

You have the right to have the denied portions of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:
