Yes, as admitted, the public body failed to comply with proper redactions however I don't see how that allows them to make any type of demands of a private citizen to return those documents nor require them to expend money and provide a notarized letter confirming destruction of the records they provided.

I consider their demands to be outside the authority of the FOI Act and hereby request a review by the Public Access Counselor.
