RE: Activity

The radio logs reflect you are spending entirely too much time 10-6 at various locations (especially L-1), when you should be on the street. I further expect you to radio and notify the Control Room each and every time you get in and out of the car and on 10/50 (the radio logs reflect you seldom call 10-8). I have addressed both of the aforementioned topics to all patrol officers through past shift briefings, so I assume you were aware of my wishes. I have further discussed with you in the past the need for you to improve your activity to the point that it is consistent with that of the other patrol sergeants. I wish to speak with you about this in person when I come to work at 8:30am, Tuesday, June 5, 1984, before you go to the DUI training class.
