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Thank you for writing to the Will County Treasurer's Office with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140 *et seq*). In your email, you requested bank account information as to where our office distributes property tax levy revenue to DuPage Community College District 502.

Your request is granted in part and denied in part as follows:

1. Our office deposits real estate property tax levy revenue for District 502 at two banks during your requested period.
  1. Associated Bank (Levy 2011-2012), 200 East Randolph Street, Chicago, IL 60601
  2. BMO Harris Bank (Levy 2013-2014), 111 West Monroe Street, Chicago, IL 60603

The Will County Treasurer's Office is denying your request for the following reasons:

1. Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act at 5 ICLS 140/2(a), a "person" means any individual, corporation, partnership, firm, organization, or association, acting individually or as a group. By this definition, the DuPage Community College District 502, being a corporate body established under the laws of the State of Illinois, is a person pursuant to the Act.
2. Pursuant to the Act at 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5), "private information" means unique identifiers, including financial information. A bank account number is financial information.
3. Pursuant to the Act at 5 ILCs 140/7(1)(c), we will not provide the bank account number is it is private information expressly exempt from disclosure.

Brian McDaniel, the FOIA Officer for the Will County Treasurer's Office, was responsible for making this decision. You have a right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your request for review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in state circuit court (5 ILCS 140/11).

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a)). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
