Dear Mr. Allen:

On January 28, 2016, the College of DuPage ("College") received your Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request via email dated January 27, 2016. You requested as follows:

1. Copy of all payments made to JLL, LLC and/or John Lininger during the last 5 years.
2. Copy of all work product produced under the 2014 contract JLL, LLC entered into with COD, signed by Tom Glaser
3. Board minutes where the 2014 contract with JLL was approved.
4. The contract has this statement on the second page (see below). I am requesting all of those documents claimed to have been included, which is the RFP documents and the Contractors responding proposal.

On February 4, 2016, the College extended its time to respond to your request under FOIA, 5 ICLS 140/3(e).

With respect to parts 3 and 4 of your request, the College did not find responsive records.

With respect to parts 1 and 2 of your request, the College encloses responsive records. Please be advised that the College has redacted and withheld records under 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b). That section states:

- (1) When a request is made to inspect or copy a public record that contains information that is exempt from disclosure under this Section, but also contains information that is not exempt from disclosure, the public body may elect to redact the information that is exempt. The public body shall make the remaining information available for inspection and copying. Subject to this requirement, the following shall be exempt from inspection and copying:
 - (b) Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.

The name of the person responsible for redaction and exemption of the records is Barb Mitchell, the College's Freedom of Information Officer, who consulted with the College's legal counsel on this matter.

You may ask the Illinois Attorney General's Public Access Counselor (PAC) to review this decision concerning your records request, by submitting a Request for Review to the PAC by electronic mail or U.S. Mail within 60 days after this response. A request for Review by the PAC should be directed to:
