10 ILCS 5/9-7) (from Ch. 46, par. 9-7) Sec. 9-7. Records and accounts. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the treasurer of a political committee shall keep a detailed and exact account of-(a) the total of all contributions made to or for the committee; (b) the full name and mailing address of every person making a contribution and the date and amount thereof; (c) the total of all expenditures made by behalf of the committee; (d) the full name and mailing address of every person to whom any expenditure is made, and the date and amount thereof; (e) proof of payment, stating the particulars, for every expenditure made by or on behalf of the committee.

Section 3:

There are various reports in the local Ottawa newspaper "The Times", The Illinois Times, and the Edgar County Watchdogs questioning the documentation of the spending of Mr. Mautino's Campaign. A majority of the expenses are recorded in whole dollar amounts, which strains reason to believe these expenses are for actual services rendered. An invoice almost never rounds to whole numbers, especially when repairs and fuel expenses are paid. Of particular interest is the documentation of expenditures made directly to a Spring Valley City Bank. It is apparent the bank could not be providing the services for which the expenses were paid. Additionally, extremely high amounts of expenses were allocated to Happy's Super Service in Spring Valley. The amounts totaled over \$200,000

in just over a ten year period. No reasonable person would spend this type of money on fuel and expenses in this time period, especially when normal legislative travel expenses are reimbursed from the state. It would have been possible to lease a vehicle or purchase new vehicles for much less that expensed.

These identified expense documentation issues deserve to have an audit performed by an independent firm to ensure compliance with the statutory requirements. I am asking the State Board of Election to perform whatever actions are necessary to resolve the questions I have briefly outlined and seek information and documentation from the above referenced who have additional information and documentation.
