I, Kevin Sangston, being duly sworn on oath do state as follows:

1. I am the Chief of Police in the city of Spring Valley, Illinois.

2. I joined the State's Attorney Felony Enforce Unit (S.A.F.E.) in the fall of 2011 and I am still a participant along with the LaSalle County State's Attorney's Office.

3. I have assigned Sgt. Edward K. Jauch to the S.A.F.E. unit to work in conjunction with the other members.

4. It is my understanding that Edward K. Jauch is the primary investigator with regard to all S.A.F.E. cases and his duties include but are not limited to processing all of the evidence, doing all of the interviews, and assisting in the search and processing of vehicles transporting narcotics. Edward J. Jauch is also responsible for initiating any and all follow up investigations which will assist in the prosecution of defendants in S.A.F.E. cases.

5. I have also provided an evidence vault to store all evidence obtained by the S.A.F.E. unit as well as providing dispatch assistance to the S.A.F.E. unit. I have also provided a K-9 officer from the Spring Valley Police Department to assist the S.A.F.E. unit when needed.

6. It is my understanding that as a participating agency in the S.A.F.E. unit that the Spring Valley Police Department would receive 65% of all monies and the sale proceeds of all other property forfeited pursuant to the Narcotics Laws of the State of Illinois.

7. I understand that pursuant to the Laws of the State of Illinois that the money I receive shall be used for the enforcement of laws regulating cannabis, methamphetamine, and other controlled substances.
