Our denial is based upon Section 2-123(f-5) of the Illinois Vehicle Code [625 ILCS 5/2-123(f-5)] and therefore Section 7 (1)(a) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act [5 ILCS 140/7(1)(a)]. The Secretary of State is statutorily prohibited from releasing the information to you as your request does not fit within any of the parameters that would permit the Secretary of State from releasing the information to you. Accordingly, your request is denied.
