

Public Disclosure: College of DuPage status changed from "Accredited – On Probation" to "Accredited" Effective: November 2, 2017

The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) has removed the sanction of Probation for College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn, Illinois.

HLC took this action based on the College's ability to demonstrate that it meets HLC's Criteria for Accreditation.

It was placed on Probation in December 2015 for concerns related to integrity and governance issues.

Next Steps

HLC will continue to monitor the institution and has requested that the College file a report with HLC by May 15, 2018 on topics including processes related to course outcomes as well as documentation of credit-hour calculation for all delivery methods.

The College additionally will host a focused visit by September 2019 addressing ethical behavior and training among its board of trustees, and leadership support of collaborative processes. The visit also will look at student assessment and outcomes; student retention, persistence, and completion; planning and success measurements; and institutional performance improvement.
