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1 THE COURT: People versus Ronald Wells, 18-CF-24. 2 Mr. Wells, please come forward and have a seat beside 3 your attorney. MR. MCGRATH: We're ready, Your Honor. 4 5 THE COURT: State may call its first witness. 6 MR. HUTSON: State would call Jeremiah Hanley, 7 Your Honor. THE COURT: Please raise your right hand. 8 9 (Witness sworn.) THE COURT: Please have a seat in the witness 10 11 chair. You may proceed when ready. 12 DEPUTY JEREMIAH HANLEY, 13 called as a witness on behalf of the State, being first duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows: 14 15 DIRECT EXAMINATION 16 BY MR. HUTSON: 17 Please state your name. Q. 18 Α. Jeremiah Hanley. 19 Ο. How are you employed? 20 Α. Deputy Sheriff, Clark County, Illinois. 21 On October 18, 2017, was the Clark County Ο. 2.2 Sheriff's Office contacted by the Illinois Department of 23 Children and Family Services? 24 Α. We were.

1	Q. Was that in regards to a minor that I'll refer to
2	as Jane Doe?
3	A. It was.
4	Q. And what was reported by the Department of
5	Children and Family Services?
6	A. It was reported to Department of Children and
7	Family Services by a school employee that they had
8	received information from a male student, the brother of
9	Jane Doe, that he had overheard Jane Doe and mother
10	speaking about an incident occurring between Jane Doe
11	and her grandfather.
12	Q. Was an interview of Jane Doe conducted at the
13	Children's Advocacy Center in Charleston?
14	A. It was.
15	Q. Was that on October 23, 2017?
16	A. It was.
17	Q. Were you present for that interview?
18	A. I was.
19	Q. Was the interview audio and video recorded?
20	A. It was.
21	Q. Did Jane Doe state how old she was?
22	A. She was 13.
23	Q. Did Jane Doe indicate if she was related to the
24	defendant, Ronald Wells?

1	A. She advised that he was her biological			
2	grandfather.			
3	Q. What did Jane Doe report had been occurring			
4	between her and Ronald Wells?			
5	A. She indicated to the interviewer that over the			
6	last year, not on every weekend, on just different			
7	weekends, that while she was at the residence of her			
8	grandfather, Ronald Wells, that he would inappropriately			
9	touch her and have sexual intercourse with her.			
10	Q. Did she indicate that was by placing his penis in			
11	her vagina?			
12	A. Correct.			
13	Q. And where did she say that this occurred?			
14	A. She indicated this occurred in a bedroom at the			
15	residence that is his room.			
16	Q. And are you familiar with Ronald Wells' address?			
17	A. I am.			
18	Q. Is it in Dennison, Clark County, Illinois?			
19	A. It is, on Fern Lake Road.			
20	Q. Is that where Jane Doe indicated these incidents			
21	occurred?			
22	A. Yes, it is, correct.			
23	Q. Did Jane Doe indicate when the last time Ronald			
24	Wells put his penis in Jane Doe's vagina?			

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1	A. She advised that the weekend prior he had
2	attempted, but she had stopped it. The last time it
3	actually occurred was the weekend prior to that.
4	Q. So the weekend prior being, she did the interview
5	in October of, October 23 of 2017?
6	A. Correct.
7	Q. So
8	A. It would have been the Sunday prior to that he
9	had attempted. She told him she didn't want to do it.
10	She went to the living room and laid on the couch. The
11	weekend prior to that one would have been the last time
12	that it actually occurred.
13	Q. I think you answered this, but did she indicate
14	how long this sexual contact had been going on?
15	A. She said since she was 12.
16	Q. Was Jane Doe physically examined by medical
17	professionals?
18	A. She was. She was physically examined by Sarah
19	Bush Hospital. They have a nurse that that's what she
20	does.
21	Q. Do you know approximately when she did the
22	physical examination?
23	A. Within that following week of the interview.
24	Q. Was there a report regarding the physical

1	examination?		
2	A. There was.		
3	Q. And have you read that report?		
4	A. I have. The medical examiner indicated that		
5	there was trauma to her vagina area consistent with a		
6	sexual assault.		
7	Q. And have you spoken with Ronald Wells?		
8	A. I did.		
9	Q. Did he give his date of birth?		
10	A. He was born in March of 1956, I believe, I don't		
11	remember the exact date.		
12	Q. Did he indicate that he is the grandfather of		
13	Jane Doe?		
14	A. He did.		
15	Q. Did he indicate that Jane Doe would stay at his		
16	house as she had reported at Fern Lake Road in Clark		
17	County, Illinois?		
18	A. He did.		
19	Q. Did he indicate that he and Jane Doe would be		
20	alone in her bedroom together?		
21	A. He also indicated that.		
22	MR. HUTSON: Thank you. No further questions.		
23	THE COURT: Cross examination?		
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1	CROSS EXAMINATION		
2	BY MR. McGRATH:		
3	Q. Deputy, did Mr. Wells tell you that he committed		
4	any crimes?		
5	A. He did not admit to any crimes, no.		
6	Q. And did you give him specific statements as to		
7	what you believed had occurred?		
8	A. I did. I discussed what was told to me that had		
9	occurred.		
10	Q. And you were doing that in an attempt to get him		
11	to admit that he had done those things, correct?		
12	A. My goal was to find out the truth. So if indeed		
13	that occurred, then, yes, I wanted him to tell me the		
14	truth.		
15	Q. When he said Did he say it didn't happen or		
16	did he not respond?		
17	A. He said it didn't happen.		
18	Q. Other than the interview of Jane Doe, was there		
19	any other witness to Jane Doe saying that this happened?		
20	A. Correct, there is.		
21	Q. Who would that be?		
22	A. There was another female juvenile that is a		
23	friend of hers that she had confided in.		
24	Q. Is that in your report?		

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1	Α.	It is.
2	Q.	So other than the other juvenile, you said that
3	the br	other had reported a conversation that Jane Doe
4	had wi	th his mother?
5	Α.	Correct, she had told her mother also.
6	Q.	Did you talk to the mother?
7	Α.	I did.
8	Q.	Did she confirm that Jane Doe had said those
9	things	?
10	Α.	Yes.
11	Q.	Had she herself witnessed anything, the mother?
12	Α.	The mother had not witnessed anything, no.
13	Q.	Had she confirmed the time frame that Jane Doe
14	might	have been alone with Mr. Wells?
15	Α.	She confirmed that she was at the residence with
16	him.	
17	Q.	Did she confirm they were together in the
18	bedroo	m ?
19	Α.	She wasn't there, so she couldn't confirm that.
20		MR. McGRATH: Thank you, Judge, that's all I
21	have.	
22		THE COURT: Redirect?
23		MR. HUTSON: Nothing further, Your Honor.
24		THE COURT: You may step down, Deputy. Thank

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1 you. 2 (Witness excused.) THE COURT: Does the State have any further 3 evidence? 4 5 MR. HUTSON: No, Your Honor. 6 THE COURT: Argument or evidence? 7 MR. MCGRATH: No, Your Honor. THE COURT: Okay. The Court finds that the State 8 9 has established probable cause. Is the Defendant ready 10 to proceed to arraignment? 11 MR. MCGRATH: Yes, Your Honor, plead not guilty and ask for a jury trial. 12 13 THE COURT: The record will so reflect. I will enter a Scheduling Order setting this matter for jury 14 trial on May 8 at 8:00 and for pretrial conference on 15 16 April 23 at 9:00. 17 Does the State have anything more? 18 MR. HUTSON: No, thank you, Your Honor. 19 THE COURT: Does the Defendant? 20 MR. MCGRATH: No, Your Honor. 21 THE COURT: Okay. That will conclude matters 22 this morning. Mr. Wells, the clerk will give you a 23 written notice of those next hearing dates. 24 (End of proceedings.)
