Dear Mr. Allen:

Thank you for writing to Algonquin Township with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1, et seq. On November 13, 2017, you requested:

1. *A copy of any personal reimbursements made to the Township for credit card purchases since January 1, 2011.*

This request was not received by the Township until January 3, 2018. Your request is responded to by Algonquin Township Clerk, Karen Lukasik, as follows:

Your request is denied pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/3(g) because the request for information is unduly burdensome to the operation of the public body. Locating, reviewing and scanning copies of any personal reimbursements made to the Township for credit card purchases since January 1, 2011 will require a great deal of time which will cause employees to dedicate such time to this FOIA and not to Township operations.



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You have a right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You may file your request for review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the state circuit court. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a request for review with the PAC.
