Due to this problem, we are making changes to our building and will relocate our board room from the central part of the third floor to our first floor by the public entrance.

People will then be able to simply enter and leave our meetings without any impediment and will still be segregated from the employee section of our building.

The Tollway recognizes the importance and philosophy of the open meetings act and transparency it is meant to foster. Recognizing that importance, we live stream all our board and committee meetings and archive videos of those meeting on our website.
