Resolution Recognizing Board's Delegating Authority to Employ Township Supervisor's Employees to Township Supervisor

WHEREAS, Algonquin Township is a unit of local government in McHenry County, State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/et seq, took effect on January 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Township Code is designed to enumerate the various responsibilities and actions of a Township and its elected officials; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 60 ILCS 1/70-15(a) the Township Supervisor is the Chief Executive Officer of the Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 60 ILCS 1/100-5, the Township Board has the authority to employ and fix the compensation of township employees; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board may delegate the authority to employ and fix the compensation of a township employee to the Township Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the Township Supervisor has authority to hire for his own office within his budgetary constraints and desires to hire support staff for his office; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be a conflict in the laws and the Township Supervisor and the Township Board want to make it clear that the Supervisor has the authority to hire employees for the operation of the Township within his budgetary authority.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Algonquin Township Board, McHenry County, Illinois, that:

1. RECITALS. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated here as if set forth fully here.
2. GRANTING OF AUTHORITY. The Supervisor is granted the authority to make all employment decisions pertaining to employees in the Township, including hiring, terminating and fixing compensation, within the Supervisor's budgetary authority.
3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from August ____, 2018.
