COMPLAINT

NOW COMES Plaintiff, KIRK ALLEN by his undersigned attorneys, Loevy & Loevy, and brings this suit to overturn Defendant WESLEY TOWNSHIP refusal, in willful and intentional violation of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, to properly respond to ALLEN's Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request. In support of his Complaint, ALLEN states as follows:

INTRODUCTION

1. Pursuant to the fundamental philosophy of the American constitutional form of government, it is the public policy of the State of Illinois that all persons are entitled to full and complete information regarding the affairs of government and the official acts and policies of those who represent them as public officials and public employees consistent with the terms of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). 5 ILCS 140/1.

2. Restraints on access to information, to the extent permitted by FOIA, are limited exceptions to the principle that the people of this state have a right to full disclosure of information relating to the decisions, policies, procedures, rules, standards, and other aspects of

government activity that affect the conduct of government and the lives of the people. 5 ILCS 140/1.

3. All public records of a public body are presumed to be open to inspection or copying. Any public body that asserts that a record is exempt from disclosure has the burden of proving by clear and convincing evidence that it is exempt. 5 ILCS 140/3.

4. Under FOIA Section 11(h), "except as to causes the court considers to be of greater importance, proceedings arising under [FOIA] shall take precedence on the docket over all other causes and be assigned for hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way."

PARTIES

5. Plaintiff KIRK ALLEN is the FOIA requester in this case, and,

6. Defendant WESLEY TOWNSHIP is a public body located in Will County.

AUGUST 2, 2018 FOIA REQUEST

7. On August 2, 2018, ALLEN submitted requests for various records. Exhibit A.

8. On August 2, 2018, WESLEY TOWNSHIP responded to ALLEN's FOIA request informing him that the clerk was out of town for the next few weeks and that she would look into it when she returned. Exhibit B.

9. On August 6, 2018, WESLEY TOWNSHIP requested a 10 day extension to the FOIA request. Exhibit C.

10. On August 6, 2018, ALLEN responded to WESLEY TOWNSHIP and advised that he did not agree to a 10 day extension. Exhibit D.

11. On August 16, 2018, Allen followed up with WESLEY TOWNSHIP informing it that the FOIA request was past due and the records should be provided. Exhibit E.

12. While ALLEN did not agree to production being delayed a "few weeks" or the 10

day extension, WESLEY TOWNSHIP failed to produce any records or even send ALLEN a follow-up communication of any kind long after these extended "deadlines."

13. As of the date of the filing of this Complaint, nearly two months after the filing of the FOIA request, WESLEY TOWNSHIP has not responded further or produced any records.

COUNT I – AUGUST 2, 2018 VIOLATION OF FOIA

14. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.

15. WESLEY TOWNSHIP is a public body under FOIA.

16. The records sought in ALLEN's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of WESLEY TOWNSHIP.

17. WESLEY TOWNSHIP violated FOIA by failing to produce the requested records.

COUNT II – AUGUST 2, 2018, WILLFUL VIOLATION OF FOIA

18. The above paragraphs are incorporated by reference.

19. WESLEY TOWNSHIP is a public body under FOIA.

20. The records sought in ALLEN's FOIA request are non-exempt public records of WESLEY TOWNSHIP.

21. WESLEY TOWNSHIP willfully and intentionally violated FOIA by failing to produce the requested records.

WHEREFORE, ALLEN asks that the Court:

in accordance with FOIA Section 11(f), afford this case precedence on the Court's docket except as to causes the Court considers to be of greater importance, assign this case for hearing and trial at the earliest practicable date, and expedite this case in every way;

- ii. declare that WESLEY TOWNHIP has violated FOIA;
- iii. order WESLEY TOWNSHIP to produce the requested records;
- enjoin WESLEY TOWNSHIP from withholding non-exempt public records under FOIA;
- v. order WESLEY TOWNSHIP to pay civil penalties;
- vi. award Plaintiff reasonable attorneys' fees if Plaintiff hires an attorney for this cause, and costs;
- vii. award such other relief the Court considers appropriate.

If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me. Rolling production is not to be perceived as an agreement to extend the timeframe for compliance under FOIA.

If you are not the FOIA officer responsible for any part of this request you are required by law to forward it to the appropriate FOIA officer.

The purpose of the request is to access and disseminate information regarding the legal rights of the general public and is not for the principal purpose of personal or commercial benefit.

As outlined in FOIA, documents shall be furnished without charge or at a reduced charge, as determined by the public body, if the person requesting the documents states the specific purpose for the request and indicates that a waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest. Waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest if the principal purpose of the request is to access and disseminate information regarding the health, safety and welfare or the legal rights of the general public and is not for the principal purpose of personal or commercial benefit.

I am requesting the records be provided in electronic format if that is the method in which they are stored. If they are in paper form and the copier can convert them to electronic format I would appreciate receiving them electronically.
