BOARD LEGAL COUNSEL - Duties of Board Legal Counsel

Legal Counsel

The Board shall appoint a Legal Counsel who is not a member of the Board to serve at the pleasure of the Board. Such Legal Counsel shall, upon the instructions of the Board or the Superintendent on behalf of the Board, render legal opinions, represent the District in legal proceedings, review and prepare legal documents and attend those meetings of the Board identified by the Board as requiring the presence of Legal Counsel. The Legal Counsel shall call the Board's attention to any action or proposed action, which is contrary to Federal or State laws, or the policies of the District or the State Board, or to contracts between the District and any person, association, corporation or governmental entity.
