15. A Review Hearing is set for 2/28/2000 at 8:30 AM when you shall appear and the Court shall review the terms and conditions required to be met in this Order. If all terms and conditions are met, then you shall not be required to appear at the Review Hearing.

16. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you shall be subject to the Administrative Sanctions Program established by the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit. The Probation Department may invoke any sanction of this Program for violation of the terms and conditions of this Order.

17. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon motion of the State's Attorney, the Court allows the State's Attorney a per diem fee of \$25.00 for each of \_\_\_\_\_ days actually employed in the trial of this cause.

18. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, having considered your ability to pay, a probation fee of \$25.00 \_\_\_\_\_ for each month of actively supervised public service work, probation, conditional discharge, or supervision is imposed upon you as costs.

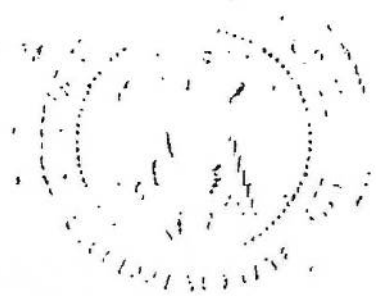
