Dear Mr. Kraft:

This letter is in further response to the FOIA submitted on February 8, 2019, which the Township responded to on February 13, 2019, and your email follow-up on February 21, 2019:

Based on the initial FOIA request, the Township did contact Shaklee Corporation to request any additional documents not in the Township's possession. All documents the Township was able to obtain responsive to your request were provided as indicated in the initial response. Based on your recent email, the Township did again reach out to Shaklee "for the contract/agreement, and any down or upline info," but Shaklee was not able to provide additional documents responsive to your request. However, as you requested "info," the Township does identify that Jennifer Johnson was the upline sponsor, the Township never had any downline.

You have a right to have a denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of a denial by filing a lawsuit in the state circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
