RESOLUTION 16-03

**SETTING COMPENSATION OF DUPAGE TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS
FOR THE FOUR YEAR TERM BEGINNING MAY 20, 2017**

WHEREAS, according to 60 ILCS 1/65-20, the compensation of the Township Officers shall be set by the Township Board at least 180 days before the beginning of the terms of office.

WHEREAS, according to 35 ILCS 200/2-70, the compensation the Township Assessor and Collector shall be set by the Township Board at the same time the Board sets the compensation of its Township Supervisor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Board of Trustees of DuPage Township that the compensation of the Township Officials for the four year term beginning May 20, 2017 and ending May 15, 2021 (January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2021 for Assessor and Collector) shall be as follows:

SECTION 1: The annual salaries for the Township Officials shall be as follows:

Supervisor's Salary: Effective for each of the following years:

For the 4 Year Term beginning May 15, 2017 - \$ 29,000

Township Clerk: Effective for each of the following years:

For the 4 Year Term beginning May 15, 2017 - \$ 15,000

Trustees: Effective for each of the following years:

For the 4 Year Term beginning May 15, 2017 - \$ 5,000

Assessor: Effective for each of the following years:

January 1, 2018 - December 31, 2018 - \$ 90,000
January 1, 2019 - December 31, 2019 - \$ 93,000
January 1, 2020 - December 31, 2020 - \$ 96,000
January 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021 - \$ 99,000

Tax Collector: Effective for each of the following years:

SECTION 2: The following Township Offices will receive Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund benefits in addition to the compensation outlined in Section 1: **Supervisor** and Assessor.

SECTION 3: **The Assessor will receive Insurance benefits** consistent with the benefits that are currently in effect for any full-time employees of the Township in addition to the compensation outlined in Section 1. This benefit shall also include the payment of any costs that are assessed to full-time employees.

ADOPTED by a majority of the DuPage Township Board of Trustees, Will County, Illinois, at a meeting held on this 23rd day of August, 2016, pursuant to a roll call vote by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of DuPage Township.
