EVIDENCE OF PURGE

Now Comes Andrew Gasser, Algonquin Township Highway Commissioner, and Algonquin Township Road District by and through thier attorney, Robert T. Hanlon, with evidence of Purge and states as follows:

The power to punish for contempt rests within the sound discretion of the trial court. (*In re Estate of Maslowe* (1985), 133 Ill.App.3d 1043, 89 Ill.Dec. 174, 479 N.E.2d 1180.) *Cent. Prod. Credit Ass'n v. Kruse*, 156 Ill. App. 3d 526, 531, 509 N.E.2d 136 (1987). Nevertheless, there are limitations to impose contempt. The power to impose contempt is an extraordinary one and, thus, should be exercised only in extreme situations. (*People ex rel. Woodward v. Oliver* (1975), 25 Ill.App.3d 66, 322 N.E.2d 240.) It should not be used when other adequate remedies are available. *People v. Mowery* (1983), 116 Ill.App.3d 695, 72 Ill.Dec. 238, 452 N.E.2d 363.

In the instant case, Local 150 alleged indirect civil contempt on the basis that an arbitrator had not been selected for each of the panels. The Court order of March 1, 2019 specifies the act of failing to contact the FMCS as the basis for finding of Contempt. Civil

contempt is coercive in intent, and ordinarily consists of failing to do something ordered to be done by a court in a civil action for the benefit of an opposing litigant. *People ex rel. Kazubowski* v. *Ray* (1971), 48 Ill.2d 413, 416, 272 N.E.2d 225.

Civil Contempt grants to the contemnor the keys to his freedom. Given the coercive nature of civil contempt proceedings and that the respondent may purge him or herself of contempt. See *People v. Jashunsky*, 51 Ill. 2d 220, 224, 282 N.E.2d 1, 3 (1972) (stating that due process requires that the defendant be made aware of ways to purge himself of contempt), cert. denied, 409 U.S. 989 (1972); see also *Pryweller v. Pryweller*, 218 Ill. App. 3d 619, 633, 579 N.E.2d 432, 442 (1st Dist. 1991) (finding that a civil contempt order must set forth conditions by which the contemnor may purge herself).

Despite the mandate of the appellate court in *Pryweller v. Pryweller* and *People v. Jashunsky* cited above, nothing in the Court's order of March 1, 2019 sets forth the due process requirement of informing Andrew Gasser of the Court's requirement for the purging of the contempt.

Moreover, within this Court's order, the court found that it was obligation of Andrew Gasser to request the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS) for replacement panels that were stricken in the entirety by the Road District, even though there is no order commanding Andrew Gasser to order panels from FCMS. See Order of 3/1/2019.

Further, the original Petition for Rule complained of is the failure to select an arbitrator. Here, in this case, Andrew Gasser requested new panels from FCMS. FCMS has been requested to provide new panels and the parties have participated in the arbitrator selection process to the point that the arbitrator for each grievance has been selected. See Group Exhibit A.

Accordingly, applying any reasonable standard, the Defendants have purged any

contempt complained of by Plaintiffs.

Moreover, given that each panel has selected an arbitrator, Defendant Andrew Gasser has

done everything possible to purge the order of 3/1/2019. In fact, not only did Andrew Gasser

complete all ordering of panels from FCMS despite the language of Section 8.3 that places that

obligation in the hands of Local 150, he has made all necessary strikes to each panel to arrive at

an arbitrator in the respective grievance claims of Local 150. Here, Andrew Gasser, acting in his

official capacity, has done everything possible to purge the contempt complained of by Local

150.

All panels were ordered on or before March 4, 2019, and all selections were completed

on or before March 22, 2019.

Wherefore the reasons set forth herein, Andrew Gasser prays that this court

recognize that he has ample evidence of purge at this time.
