REPORT TITLE/PURPOSE

To document the interview of Drake L. Jackson

NARRATIVE SECTION

The purpose of this report is to document the interview of Drake L. Jackson.

The interview took place at his residence of [REDACTED] at 04:18 p.m. The interview was conducted by myself and FBI Special Agent Charles Willenborg. The interview is in regards to a meeting that went into executive session where a vote took place and statements were made during a Cahokia board meeting. The interview was preserved on video. A copy of the interview will be stored on a DVD and placed into evidence and another copy will be maintained in the case file. The St. Clair County video interview checklist was completed and attached. The St. Clair County Miranda Rights form was completed and attached. The originals will be maintained in a 1A envelope in the case file. The following is a synopsis of the interview and should not be considered a verbatim account.

Jackson said a deputy with the St. Clair County Sheriff's Department came to his residence and served him a subpoena in regards to the meeting. Jackson called Pearson and asked her if she received a subpoena and her response was, "Yes."

NARRATIVE SECTION

Jackson stated there was a special meeting held on the night of January 7th, 2015 at Cahokia city hall. Jackson said the meeting was in regards to a complaint filed by mayoral candidate David Fultz in reference to the mayoral election coming up in April. The question being proposed was, "Does Curtis McCall Jr. need to list himself as Jr. or is Curtis McCall suffice?" The meeting went into executive session to vote whether or not Curtis McCall Jr. should remain on the ballot because his name only shows on the ballot as Curtis McCall. His father, Curtis McCall Sr. is also involved in politics in the city of Cahokia.

According to Jackson, the following people were present in executive session:

-Phyllis Pearson, Jerry Nichols, City Attorney Carmen Durzo and himself.

Jackson and Pearson voted to keep the name Curtis McCall on the ballot and Jerry Nichols voted to remove McCall from the ballot. Jackson believes Nichols voted no because McCall Jr. was running under the influence of his father to obtain votes for the mayoral election. Jackson advised the city attorney asked Jackson, Pearson and Nichols if any of them were approached by anyone to persuade their vote in executive session. Jackson said no one approached him nor Pearson. According to Jackson, Nichols said he was approached by Curtis McCall Sr., Curtis McCall Jr., and Mike Crockett. Jackson asked Nichols to elaborate more on how he was approached by the above three names. Nichols along with the city attorney said that Nichols does not have to disclose what was discussed between those individuals.

Jackson said he was never approached by anyone on the McCall team. Jackson said after the meeting this topic has not been discussed since. Jackson later admitted that he spoke with Curtis McCall Sr. at the school where they are both employed. Jackson asked McCall Sr. if he, McCall Jr. or Crockett approached Nichols. Jackson said McCall Sr. was shocked by the allegation and asked, "Why would I do something like that." Jackson saw Mike Crockett in public and told him about the allegations. According to Jackson, Crockett "just blew the allegation off." Jackson spoke with McCall Jr. the night of the vote and McCall Jr. responded, "like really?"

Jackson said if the law read that McCall Jr. had to specifically list his suffix "Jr." on the ballot, than he would have voted to remove McCall Jr. even though Jackson is associated with their team. Jackson believes that Nichols is not telling the truth in regards to this matter because he is a faithful follower of the current mayor Gary Cornwell.

The interview was concluded at 04:50 p.m.

The interview is in regards to a meeting that went into executive session where a vote took place and statements were made during that executive session.

The interview was preserved on video. A copy of the interview will be stored on a DVD and placed into evidence and another copy will be maintained in the case file. The St. Clair County video interview checklist was completed and attached. The St. Clair County Miranda Rights form was completed and attached. The originals will be maintained in a 1A envelope in the case file. The following is a synopsis of the interview, and should not be considered a verbatim account.

At the request of Pearson, she did not want to give a statement while being audio and video recorded. I completed the video statement checklist and Miranda rights form on video. The audio/video was concluded at 05:15 p.m.

NARRATIVE SECTION

Pearson informed myself and Willenborg there was a special board meeting on January 7th, 2015 at the Cahokia city hall in regards to the upcoming Cahokia mayoral election. A mayoral candidate David Fultz is challenging Curtis McCall and whether or not his suffix "Jr." needs to be listed on the ballot. Curtis McCall Sr. is also active in politics in the city of Cahokia. The board meeting went into executive session.

According to Pearson, the following people were in attendance:

Jerry Nichols, Drake Jackson, city attorney Carmen Durzo and herself.

Pearson advised the votes were 2-1 to keep Curtis McCall on the ballot. Pearson said her and Jackson were the yes votes and Nichols was the no vote. Pearson said the city attorney asked them if anyone had approached them or influenced them on the vote. Pearson and Jackson stated, "No" and Nichols stated, "Yes."

According to Pearson, Nichols said he was approached by Curtis McCall Sr., Curtis McCall Jr. and Mike Crockett. Pearson did not ask Nichols what was discussed between the above individuals.

Pearson said she is affiliated with the McCall team but has not been approached or influenced by anyone on the McCall team prior to the special meeting. Pearson did not have any contact with any member of the McCall team after the board meeting in regards to the executive session. Pearson said she follows all rules of campaigning in regards to an election.

The interview was concluded at 05:34 p.m.

On December 1st, 2015, at 09:24 a.m., I, Trooper Derek Weh #5943 attempted to contact Special Prosecutor David Rands via cell phone and left a message asking him to return my call so I can receive an update on this case.

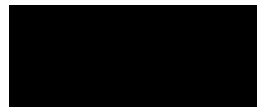
