On August 15, 2019 Officer Campos responded to 1095 S. Water to speak with
happened at the Dollar General 107 W. Kahler. Upon arrival Officer Campos spoke with

about an altercation that
who related the following: She was

in line at Dollar General when she saw John Norton in line in front of her; [redacted] has had previous negative contacts with Norton. Norton paid for his items and continued to stand in line talking to the cashier. Several people including [redacted] asked Norton to please step aside so the line could proceed. Norton approached [redacted] in an aggressive manner (loud voice, clinched fist) and got approximately two feet from her face a called her a bitch. Another customer [redacted] told Norton not to talk to her in that manner. Norton called [redacted] a bitch again. [redacted] said she was going to call the police if Norton continued. Norton said call the police then walked out of the store. [redacted] told Norton that she wasn't going to let her walk outside by herself because she was afraid Norton may do something to her. [redacted] and [redacted] both walked out together and Norton drove away. Officer Campos made contact with [redacted] who stated that Norton got upset when customers asked that me move out of the way of the line so other customers could proceed. Norton then directed his anger at [redacted] calling her a bitch several times. [redacted] stated that she couldn't believe how Norton talked to [redacted] and that Norton wasn't provoked by [redacted] at all. [redacted] said that she was scared that Norton was going to hurt [redacted] so she walked outside with her to her car. Officer Campos spoke to the cashier at Dollar General [redacted] who stated that Norton had paid for his items but continued to talk to her and wouldn't leave the line so other customers could proceed. She stated that Norton was "talking crazy" and made no sense of what he was saying and that she was scared by him. Norton told her that he knew how to kill people and get away with it. Once customers asked Norton to step aside he approached [redacted] and called her a bitch several times and stated that she was the one that starts all the shit in town. He soon left the store. Officer Campos located Norton at his residence. Upon approaching Norton in his driveway his daughter [redacted] was also present and she immediately stated " I told you that you can't talk to people that way, " You deserve to go to jail". See written statements for further. Officer Campos advised Norton of the incident and he stated that he did call [redacted] a bitch but Officer Campos couldn't do anything because it was freedom of speech. Officer Campos told Norton what he had done was committed disorderly conduct. Officer Campos advised Norton that he was under arrest for disorderly conduct. Officer Campos handcuffed Norton, searched his person, and placed him in the rear of his squad car. Norton was transported to the Wilmington Police Department for processing and later released on an I-bond and given a local must appear court date.
