
At approximately 1400 hrs. I was advised by the Iroquois County Dispatching Center Hubner had returned home and I could come speak with her now. At approximately 1402 hrs. I went to [REDACTED] and knocked on the door. Michael answered and invited me in. I introduced myself to Doris and told her I wanted to speak with her about the incident that had occurred at the Library Board Meeting. I asked her if there had been some tension between herself and the board. Doris replied, "I'm just here listening to you right now." I advised Doris I was asking her a question, and she again refused to answer.

I then proceeded to explain to Doris that her actions at the board meeting were unacceptable as when the meeting is adjourned she is to leave not stay around. I explained to her she is not a board member nor an employee and cannot stay. I then explained to her she is being harassing when doing that and when she continues to stay in her car across from the library after the meeting watching to see the Library Director (Reetz) leave then she is on the verge of stalking.

I then asked Hubner if she had any questions or concerns she would like to ask and she replied "no, not at this time." I then proceeded to tell her if she did, then she could contact myself or Chief Brenner and we would answer them for her.

Nothing else follows at this time.

The Onarga Public Library held its monthly board meeting on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at 7pm. There are usually 7 board members + the Library Director attending the meeting. Doris Hubner attends the meetings as a resident of Onarga.

At the September 17<sup>th</sup> meeting during public comment Doris referenced how she was a taxpayer who paid the Director's salary and should not have to pay for an agenda at the meeting. Stating "She knows I want one". The Director passes out the agendas to the Board Members as they arrive to the meeting before giving one to the public in attendance.

Doris made comments several times during the meeting without being recognized by the board President.

The Director did tell her at one point to stop interrupting the meeting.

After the meeting was adjourned roughly around 7:30pm, Doris intentionally stayed and waited upstairs for all board members to leave while 2 board members were signing checks. As the last board member (board president) was exiting, the Director went downstairs to shut off lights. When she came back upstairs, Doris was still standing at the top of the stairs. The Director told Doris that the meeting had been adjourned. She needed to leave. Doris stated that "everyone" needed to leave. The Director stated to Doris that she was an employee of the Library and had things to finish before she could leave.

The Director then went to the front door and stepped outside and held it open to encourage Doris to leave. After a few minutes she walked out on to the steps. The Director went back inside and locked the door behind her. She was inside the building for approximately 5 to 10 minutes to finish closing up the building. When the Director went to leave the building, Doris was parked across the street from the Library waiting in her vehicle. 2 Board members were waiting in their vehicles behind Doris because they wanted to make sure the Director got to her vehicle without an incident. Once the Director was in her vehicle the 2 Board Members left and then the Director left but Doris did not leave when everyone else did.
