3 A. No.

4 Q. Never parked in front of that handicap
5 parking spot?

6 A. No, I haven't.

7 Q. Did the police come out that evening to talk
8 to you?

9 A. Yes, they did.

10 Q. And after they came out and talked to you,
11 did you move your vehicle?

12 A. Yes.

13 MR. HANLON: Sorry about this, Judge. There
14 is some handwriting on an image. I need to remove it.

15 What am I up to now by way of exhibits?

16 THE COURT: This should be G.

17 MR. HANLON: Exhibit G. I have knew just
18 now for identification what is now marked as Exhibit
19 G. I'm showing a copy of Exhibit G to my opposing
20 counsel.

21 May I approach the witness, Your Honor?

22 THE COURT: Yes.

23 BY MR. HANLON:

24 Q. Mr. Norton, I'm showing you what has

1 previously been marked as Exhibit G.

2 Can you tell me whose vehicle is depicted in
3 Exhibit G?

4 A. My dad's.

5 Q. Okay. Is that a vehicle that you drive?

6 A. Yes.

7 Q. Were you driving it on the evening of August
8 the 13th?

9 A. Yes, I was.

10 Q. On that evening did you park it where it's
11 shown in that photograph?

12 A. That was a picture taken approximately 6:30
13 in the afternoon; and, yes, I was parked there.

14 Q. Okay. I would like to retrieve the exhibit
15 from the witness. Just to be clear, right in front of
16 that vehicle in Exhibit G is there something that looks
17 like a wheelchair on a sign on the side of the
18 building?

19 A. In front of my vehicle, no. From the spot to
20 the east side of it, yes.

21 MR. HANLON: May I retrieve the exhibit?

22 I would like to offer Exhibit G into
23 evidence.
