Deputy Carr handed me his badge, ID card and weapon.

RE: Internal Investigation – Administrative Leave with Pay

This morning I received copies of text messages alleged written by you. Be advised that I have ordered an internal investigation of the alleged inappropriate statements made on repeated occasions starting in January 2019. The Internal Investigation Notice is attached. I will contact you in order to make arrangements for an interview.

Deputy Carr, I am placing you on administrative leave with pay pending the outcome of this internal investigation. You are immediately ordered to turn over your Cumberland County Sheriff's Office identification card, your Cumberland County Sheriff's Office badges, and all Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and/or Cumberland County issued equipment.

Administrative Leave:

- While on Administrative Leave your access to the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and other County buildings is limited to areas of a building that are open to the public.
- While on Administrative Leave you are ordered to appear in Court on all subpoenas that may be issued. You are ordered to wear civilian clothing appropriate for an appearance in Court.
- While on Administrative Leave you will not have the privilege of representing yourself as a Deputy of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, or an employee of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office or of Cumberland County.
- While on Administrative Leave you are ordered not to discuss the subject matter of this investigation with anyone other than your union representation and/or legal counsel.

Order for Administrative Leave is effective immediately.

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On Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at approximately 7:15 p.m., I spoke with [REDACTED] at the Neoga Police Department, Neoga, Cumberland County, Illinois. Also present was [REDACTED] friend, [REDACTED]. The following is a summary of the interview and is not verbatim. A taped interview was conducted.

[REDACTED] stated she sent the text messages between her and Steve Carr to [REDACTED] electronically. [REDACTED] stated the text messages were very disturbing and concerning to her. [REDACTED] stated the last text message she received from Steve was August 1, 2019 when she told Steve to stay away from her children. [REDACTED] stated Steve has anger issues and she suggested counseling. [REDACTED] stated Steve has a personal vendetta against John Hatfill because Steve thought John was "hacking" into his cell phone. [REDACTED] stated she had to wear a sweater to the Greenup Fall Festival to cover up her bruises she received from Steve. [REDACTED] stated Steve would pull his gun and hand it to her ([REDACTED]) and say, "just shoot me". [REDACTED] stated the text messages she showed me on her cell phone were from Steve Carr. The text messages came from his cell phone.

On Tuesday, October 1, 2019 at approximately 12:05 p.m., I met with Deputy Steve Carr, Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Field Representative Ryan Olier, Illinois Fraternal Order of Police lawyer Bob Jones, and Cumberland County State's Attorney Bryan Robbins in my office at the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, Toledo, Cumberland County, Illinois. I handed Ryan the Explanation of Rights form to inform Deputy Carr what his rights are. Ryan refused to have Deputy Carr read the Explanation of Rights form. I advised Deputy Carr I would set up a time and date for the Psychological Fitness for Duty Evaluation and advise him of the date and time.

I have completed my investigation into the complaint I received from [REDACTED] relating to inappropriate text messages that you allegedly sent to her. During your interview, you could not recall sending those text messages. I also interviewed [REDACTED]. I found her account to be credible and believe that you are the source of these text messages. Your conduct is in violation of the Sheriff's Office internal policies in that you have engaged in conduct that brings this office into disrepute.

As a result, and as per your agreement, you are hereby ordered to attend a 'Fitness for Duty' evaluation on **October 24, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. with Dr. Tom Campion**. His office is located at **2110 Clear Lake Blvd., Suite 202, Champaign, Illinois**. You are directed to cooperate with the psychologist's and/or staff requests and completely and honestly answer any questions posed by them. The evaluation is being conducted for use by the department and the evaluator will release limited information to the department. You may authorize the evaluator to release additional information to the department.

Refusal to comply with this order or any of its parts, or with the reasonable requests of the evaluator, shall be deemed insubordination, and shall be grounds for disciplinary action, up to and including termination. Statements made to the evaluator shall be considered compelled and may not be used in a criminal or civil proceeding against you.
