

RESOLUTION NO. 77-8

WHEREAS, the duties of the office of the State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois, as enumerated by the Ill. Rev. Stats. Chap. 14, paragraph 5, are exceedingly broad; and

WHEREAS, from and after December 1, 1976, the number of cases, both criminal and civil, passing through and administered by the office of the State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois, have greatly increased; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County of Shelby, State of Illinois, that additional assistance be provided for the office of the State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Board for Shelby County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I: That the office of the State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois, be, and the same is hereby, authorized to expend not to exceed \$6000.00 per year for the purpose of procuring the services of a part-time Assistant State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois.


SECTION II: That the selection of said Assistant State's Attorney for Shelby County, Illinois, shall be pursuant to Ill. Rev. Stats. Chap. 14, paragraph 5a.

SECTION III: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
