Second Interview of John Rekowski

On April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016, at approximately 2:30 p.m. in continuance of Lead 51 I, Detective Lt. David Vucich DSN 98 met with:

in his office at the administration building. Rekowski is the head public defender for Madison County. I had previously located another document believed to be authored by Rekowski. The document was a letter endorsing Barack Obama as United States' Senator. It was titled Precinct Ltr.doc. It was suspected it was intercepted in Rekowski's email due to the fact the metadata showed Rekowski as the author of the document.

During this interview, I showed Rekowski and copy of the document and he immediately recognized it. Rekowski identified the document as being created by him and being emailed by him to many people. With his consent, we logged into his web based email account. Rekowski and I located the attachment which was sent to Janet Hefti who is/was the Illinois Executive Director for the board of admission to the Illinois bar association. It was sent on January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2008, at 3:50 p.m. to her email of [REDACTED]

In addition, he had also sent it to his brother:

on January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2008, at 3:26 p.m. to his email of [REDACTED]

He confirmed that there were no additional recipients, blind carbon copies (bcc's) and he never gave anyone authority to access his email to obtain it. Rekowski could not think of any way that the email would have ended up on anyone else's computer from him and said that Doug Hulme should not have been in possession of that document.
