All,

I received the email correspondence below this afternoon from Deputy Governor Jesse Ruiz regarding our Phase 4 Return to Play Guidelines. You will see that IDPH is requiring us to modify our guidelines to fall in line with the recommendations that are currently part of the ISBE guidance. This would include requiring all persons to wear masks at all times and limiting any sort of "physical contact" among athletes which will eliminate the contests between teams for many sports.

Deputy Governor Ruiz indicated a similar modification of the youth sports guidance document will be made also.

I will be making these modifications tonight and forwarding to the governor's office which will likely be approved and sent to schools tomorrow.

As you can see below, there are concerns of some recent outbreaks at some schools and the contradiction in guidance between our guidance and those of ISBE.
