Subject: RE: Lake County Outbreak

Just called your office and left a voice mail. Wanted to speak to you directly, but in the interest of time, sending this note.

I just had a call with IDPH regarding the **Lake Zurich outbreak** and the recent IHSA guidance.

The Lake Zurich situation, and the recent finding that young people are significantly contributing to the spread of virus, has caused **Dr. Ezike and our office to reassess the IDPH guidance and we feel it is necessary to require three adjustments to IHSA guidance.**

1. **There cannot be any contact drills/physical contact among athletes.**
2. **All persons must wear masks at all times.**
3. **There must be a strict 50 person limit to all indoor activities, and that would include any spectators (people in those groups should also socially distance).**

Per these three points, please send us a revised draft of the guidance for review by IDPH.

I know that changing recently-released guidance is difficult, but I know you appreciate the changes necessitated by ever-changing public health conditions. Things literally need to be assessed by the day.
