Re: Engineering Work for the City of Shelbyville

Dear Mr. Spesard:

K & M Engineering has performed a variety of design projects for the City of Shelbyville over the past five years. These were design jobs that were done in addition to my duties as the City Engineer. The following is a list of projects that are being prepared for the city by K & M Engineering.

1. Design of a new access to Rte 16 from the Meadows Subdivision, to be called N. Dacey Drive. This is a part of the Swafford Branch project being designed because of an easement consideration with the developer.
2. Dacey Drive improvement from Bondware to Rte 16. Reconstruct to allow for 80,000 # trucks.
3. Improvement of 3rd Street from Dacey Drive to Heinlein. Reconstruct to allow for 80,000 # trucks.
4. Water main extension from Boy's Acres north along Rte 128 to replace an old main. Permit and easements approved and ready for construction.

5. Drainage study on north side of Shelbyville including the area bounded by Morgan St. on the East, Rte 128 on the West, 12th St. on the North and 9th St. on the South. This project is ongoing and eventually will provide for improved surface drainage for the entire area. Plans are 75% complete to improve Broadway and Morgan from 9th St. to 10th St. with storm sewer and concrete gutter this year. In addition, the plans are 99% complete to install a new storm sewer from Broadway to the railroad east and north of Morgan to allow for separation of sanitary and storm water. This project can be let to contract as soon as easements are signed and the City Attorney is involved with us on this work.

The next phase would be to install a storm sewer from Will east to Broadway to serve as the trunk line for improving drainage to the rest of the area. Additional phases of this work will allow for improvement of other sections as time and money allow.

I expect that all of these projects will be completed in this calendar year except for the north side drainage work which I hope to be able to work with the city to complete.

Since my retirement from the Shelby County Highway Department, I have established a permanent office here in downtown Shelbyville in a building that I own, and I plan to perform engineering work from that office for local developers and local governments. I am very interested in continuing to provide engineering services for the City of Shelbyville. Water line and sewer improvements and roadway design are the areas I would offer to do for the city, similar to the work I have provided in the past.

I have enjoyed working with the city, I have a good working knowledge of the city's infrastructure and I feel that I can offer valuable assistance in the design and construction of this type of engineering work. Thank you for the opportunity to be of service to the community and please feel free to contact me any time to discuss matters of mutual concern.
