MOTION FOR NOLLE PROSEQUI

Now comes Chris E. Hitzemann, State's Attorney in and for the County of Monroe, State of Illinois, and in support of its Motion to *nolle prosequi* the charges in 2020-CM-157, states: The citation in this matter states that Defendant violated 20 ILCS 2305/8.1 (a rule or regulation of the Department of Public Health), particularly Rule 690.40 by allowing indoor service of patrons. No such rule exists; however, the State presumes that the citation intended to cite Rule 690.50. Nowhere in Rule 690.50 is indoor service of patrons prohibited. As such, the People request that this cause be *nolle prosequi*.


