



1. The weeks of Sept. 1 - Nov. 18 was in contact with my employer, the website, the people employed with, and the companies online presence to attempt to cause me a job loss. "Questioning my employment, position, duties, and supplying fabricated info on me."
2. The weeks of Sept. 1 - Nov. 18 she was in contact with online media sites for my second job in Illinois, reporters sites, and political affiliates about me, in attempts to discredit me and my reputation as a Doctor + Worker. "Joining their websites, FB sites, commenting, calling people."
3. November 16th she was cyber stalking my Linked In account, looking at my personal information.
4. I filed a third police report on 11-20-2020 for cyberstalking + harassing.
5. Five years ago I filed a cease + Decist order for the same behaviors.
6. Over 5 years she has tried to use false information to defame me.
7. I've asked her multiple times to stop cyber stalking + harassing me over 5 years.
8. We were never friends, just 2 people living in the same subdivision, yet she spends her life and every day digging into my life.
9. As a Top Secret DoD employee, my company has monitored her and deems her a high level security risk.
10. She not only cyber stalks me, she has my HOA cite me with false information. When I bring my RV to my house, by laws say I have 3 days. She reports it as being there 3 days on the first day. She reports my grass, weeds, etc. even not justified.

This Lady has a sick obsession with me and my family + now my employment. She will stop at nothing. I am afraid for her violence as well as her level of harassment + cyberstalking daily + escalating over 5 years.

**ORDER SETTING HEARING ON PETITION FOR INJUNCTION FOR PROTECTION AGAINST
() DOMESTIC VIOLENCE () REPEAT VIOLENCE () DATING VIOLENCE
() SEXUAL VIOLENCE (X) STALKING
WITHOUT ISSUANCE OF AN INTERIM TEMPORARY INJUNCTION**

The Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence filed under section 741.30, Florida Statutes, or Repeat, Dating, Sexual Violence, under section 784.046, Florida Statutes; or Stalking filed under section 784.0485, Florida Statutes, has been reviewed. This Court has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter. A Temporary Injunction for Protection against Domestic, Repeat, Dating, or Sexual Violence, or Stalking pending the hearing scheduled below, is **NOT being entered** at this time but an injunction may be entered after the hearing, depending on the findings made by the Court at that time.

SECTION I. FINDINGS

The Court finds that the facts, as stated in the Petition alone and without a hearing on the matter, do not demonstrate that the Petitioner is a victim of Domestic, Repeat, Dating, or Sexual Violence or Stalking or that the Petitioner has reasonable cause to believe that he or she is in imminent danger of becoming a victim of Domestic or Dating Violence. Therefore, there is not a sufficient factual basis upon which the court can enter a *Temporary* Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating, Sexual Violence, or Stalking prior to a hearing. A hearing is scheduled on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating, or Sexual Violence or Stalking in section II of this Order. Petitioner may amend or supplement the Petition at any time to state further reasons why an Injunction should be ordered which would be in effect until the hearing scheduled below.

SECTION II. NOTICE OF HEARING

Petitioner and Respondent are ordered to appear and testify at a hearing on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating, Sexual Violence, or Stalking on **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2020 at 9:00 A.M. before a Circuit Judge, in Courtroom TBD, Lake County Courthouse, 550 West Main Street, Tavares, Lake County, Florida** at which time the Court will consider whether a Final Injunction for Protection Against Domestic, Repeat, Dating, or Sexual Violence or Stalking should be entered. If entered, the injunction will remain in effect until a fixed date set by the Court or until modified or dissolved by the Court. At the hearing, the Court will determine whether other things should be ordered, including, for example, such matters as visitation and support.

If Petitioner and/or Respondent do not appear, orders may be entered, including the imposition of court costs or an injunction. Petitioner and Respondent will be bound by the terms of any injunction or order issued at the final hearing.

IF EITHER PETITIONER OR RESPONDENT DO NOT APPEAR AT THE FINAL HEARING, HE OR SHE WILL BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF ANY INJUNCTION OR ORDER ISSUED IN THIS MATTER.

All witnesses and evidence, if any, must be presented at this time. In cases where temporary support issues have been alleged in the pleadings, each party is ordered to bring his or her financial affidavit (Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form 12.902(b) or (c)), tax return, pay stubs, and other evidence of financial income to the hearing.

NOTICE: Because this is a civil case, there is no requirement that these proceedings be transcribed at public expense.

YOU ARE ADVISED THAT IN THIS COURT:

- N/A a. A court reporter is provided by the Court.
- X b. Electronic audio tape recording only is provided by the Court. A party may arrange in advance for the services of and provide for a court reporter to prepare a written transcript of the proceedings at that party's expense.
- N/A c. In Repeat, Dating, and Sexual Violence and Stalking cases, no electronic audio tape recording or court reporting services are provided by the Court. A party may arrange in advance for the services of and provide for a court reporter to prepare a written transcript of the proceedings at that party's expense.

A RECORD, WHICH INCLUDES A TRANSCRIPT, MAY BE REQUIRED TO SUPPORT AN APPEAL. THE PARTY SEEKING THE APPEAL IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY A COURT REPORTER. THE TRANSCRIPT MUST BE FILED WITH THE REVIEWING COURT OR THE APPEAL MAY BE DENIED.

Nothing in this order limits Petitioner's rights to dismiss the petition.



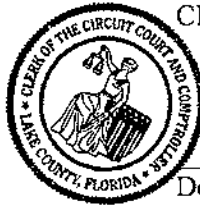

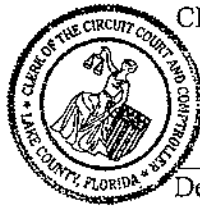
