Initial Report Agg DUI

At 4:41pm on 11/19/20 I, Deputy C. Johnson #106 was advised by Edgar County Dispatch of a single vehicle roll over accident with entrapment. I arrived on scene on 400N just West of 800E a short time later and observed a vehicle on its top in the ditch just south of 400N.

Sharon J Piper () and Clark N Piper were on scene and advised there was a female still in the car and that she was alert and appeared uninjured. Clark later stated that the female occupant stated she was uninjured but was having a difficult time moving.

I made contact with the female occupant from the driver side door as the window was slightly rolled down. The female was laying in the passenger side of the vehicle as it was upside down and the driver side was suspended higher than the passenger side.

I announced my name and capacity and asked if she were alright to which she indicated yes. I asked the Pipers if they knew her identity and they thought her name was Pam. I asked if her name was Pam to which she replied she was not Pam, that her name was Stacey Adams. She indicated that

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she were the only person within the vehicle before and after the crash. I asked her what happened and she replied, "I tried." I also asked where she were coming from and she muttered, "my son" but I was unable to understand the complete sentence as the words became slurred and falling off at the endings.

I was able to unlock the driver door and open it to further assess the situation. At this time I was able to detect a strong odor of alcoholic beverage within the passenger compartment of the vehicle. Stacey was asked if she were able to move and if she would like to attempt to exit the vehicle. She moved her extremities and began to move out of the vehicle and at this time I was able to see many small blue bottles that appeared to be alcoholic beverages (Later identified as Platinum 7 Vodka). For an unknown reason, Stacey then stopped her attempt at exiting the vehicle and we awaited Fire and EMS arrival to assist her from the vehicle.

Paris Fire and Horizon Health Ambulance arrived on scene and assessed Adams. I now was able to obtain Illinois Registration #BP73813 from the rear bumper on a 2019 Ford Utility (VIN#1FMCU0GD1KUB53679) (Silver) belonging to Stacey L Adams (residing at 7339E 400N Paris, IL. Stacey L Adams driving privilege's returned via LEADS as Revoked as well as an Restricted Driving Permit.

Paris Fire and Horizon Heath were also advised by Stacey that she were uninjured. Stacey was unable to remove herself from the vehicle unassisted despite many verbal statements stating she was unharmed. Stacey was finally removed from the vehicle but was unable to maintain her balance or a standing position. In fact, Fire and EMS had to physically hold her upright and while doing so, Stacey tried to rub their faces and varies parts of their bodies to the point the staff felt uncomfortable.

Stacey Adams was placed on a moving cloth and carried by medical personnel to the roadway and placed on a medical cot as she was unable to stand unsupported let alone walk. Sgt. A Rhoads #108 and Conservation Officer D. Miller were on scene and stood by as I departed with Horizon Health to follow up at Horizon Health ER.

At 5:35pm I arrived at the ER for follow up with Adams. Medical staff indicated she were in room 1 of the ER. I entered the room and awaited for medical staff to conduct their initial assessment then began to speak with Adams. I again stated my name/capacity and asked if she could tell me what happened. Stacey would look at me for a few moments begin to speak, then turn away. I asked if she had consumed any alcohol after the accident and she stated, no. I asked if she consumed alcohol prior to the accident to which she stated, no. Stacey was unable to tell me how the accident occurred or where she was coming from.

I observed her eyes to be bloodshot and glossy. I attempted to administer Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus but she was unable to track my Finger to conduct the test. It should be noted that she removed her eye glasses and the pupils were equal in size. During my attempts of HGN, Stacey was having difficulty keeping her eyes open as well.

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At 6:01pm Stacey L Adams was read the Illinois Warning to Motorist. Adams was requested to provide blood and urine samples to which she would not reply. After several attempts Adams was advised this action was being reflected as a refusal. Adams also refused to sign the Warning to Motorist signature line confirming the warning had been given. She was advised this was not an admission of guilt, rather a confirmation that the warning was given. Adams still refused to provide a signature.

It should be noted that Adams was also uncooperative with medical staff and would not reply to medical screenings prolonging the medical processes.

At 9:08pm I made contact with Charles Adams, the husband of Stacey. He arrived on scene as I was departing for the ER and requested to be notified. I began Speaking with Charles and he stated that his wife was granted the RDP and that it was valid from 6am-6pm for employment purposes. He indicated that it was stipulated she work for him by transporting parts or other needs for the farming operation. He went on to say that work had been slow and he hasn't needed her for employment purposes. I asked if he had any idea where she was coming from to which he stated she had taken some Chili to their son Cody's house and was returning home. I specifically asked if his wife, Stacey was used for work today and he indicated no. Charles was advised that our conversation would be reflected in my report to which he gave consent and that I was calling from my patrol unit and that the conversation would be audio recorded to which he had no issues. He finished by saying he was telling the truth and had no reason to lie. He indicated this has been an ongoing issue for 11 years and he was tired.

At 9:43pm, Adams was medically cleared and arrested for Aggravated DUI, transported to the Edgar County Jail and left in the custody of the Corrections Department.



Subsequent to an arrest for driving while under the influence of alcohol, other drug(s) or intoxicating compound(s), or any combination thereof (DUI), or Section 11-401 - leaving the scene of a fatal or personal injury accident, you are hereby notified that:

As provided in Section 11-500 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, you are a first offender unless within the last 5 years of this arrest for DUI or leaving the scene you have had:

- A previous conviction or court-assigned supervision for DUI or a similar provision of a local ordinance; or
- A conviction in any other state for DUI or a similar offense where the cause of action is the same or substantially similar to the Illinois Vehicle Code; or
- Pursuant to a DUI arrest, an Illinois driver's license suspension/revocation for refusing to submit to or failing to complete all requested chemical tests, or for submitting to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of .08 or more or any amount of a drug, substance or intoxicating compound resulting from the unlawful use or consumption of cannabis as listed in the Cannabis Control Act; a controlled substance as listed in the Illinois Controlled Substances Act; an intoxicating compound as listed in the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act; or methamphetamine as listed in the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, except in cases where you submitted to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of .08 or more or any amount of a drug, substance or intoxicating compound resulting from the unlawful use or consumption of cannabis as listed in the Cannabis Control Act; a controlled substance as listed in the Illinois Controlled Substances Act; an intoxicating compound as listed in the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act; or methamphetamine as listed in the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, and were subsequently found not guilty of the associated DUI charge.

Considering the above, you are warned:

1. If you refuse or fail to complete all chemical tests requested and:
 - If you are a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 12 months; or**
 - If you are not a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 3 years; or**
 - If you were involved in a motor vehicle accident that caused personal injury or death to another, **your driving privileges will be revoked for a minimum of 12 months.**

Personal injury means a Type A injury that requires immediate professional attention in a doctor's office or medical facility, including severely bleeding wounds, distorted extremities, and injuries that require the injured party to be carried from the scene.
2. If you submit to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of .08 or more or any amount of a drug, substance or intoxicating compound resulting from the unlawful use or consumption of cannabis as listed in the Cannabis Control Act; a controlled substance as listed in the Illinois Controlled Substances Act; an intoxicating compound as listed in the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act; or methamphetamine as listed in the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, and:
 - If you are a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 6 months; or**
 - If you are not a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 1 year.**

You are further warned that if you are a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) holder, your CDL privileges will be disqualified for the following time period if you refuse to submit to or fail to complete all chemical tests requested, or submit to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of .08 or more or any amount of a drug, substance or intoxicating compound resulting from the unlawful use or consumption of cannabis as listed in the Cannabis Control Act; a controlled substance as listed in the Illinois Controlled Substances Act; an intoxicating compound as listed in the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act; or methamphetamine as listed in the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act:

- If you have not had a prior 12-month disqualification of your CDL privileges, **your CDL privileges will be disqualified for 12 months.**
- If you have had a prior 12-month disqualification of your CDL privileges, **your CDL privileges will be disqualified for life.**

MOTORIST UNDER AGE 21

You are further warned that as a motorist under age 21, if you submit to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of more than .00 and less than .08, your driving privileges will be suspended as provided in Sections 6-208.2 and 11-501.8 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

As provided in Section 6-208.2, you are a first offender unless you have had a previous suspension under Section 11-501.8 for refusing or failing to complete a chemical test(s) or for submitting to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of more than .00.

- If you are a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 3 months; or**
- If you are not a first offender, **your driving privileges will be suspended for a minimum of 1 year.**

SCHOOL BUS DRIVER

You are further warned that as a school bus driver operating a school bus in accordance with Section 6-106.1a of the Illinois Vehicle Code, if you submit to a chemical test(s) disclosing an alcohol concentration of more than .00, your privilege to possess a school bus driver permit will be cancelled for 3 years as provided under Sections 6-106.1a and 6-106.1b of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
