JOINT STATUS REPORT

In accordance with the Court’s September 2, 2020 minute order (Dkt. 63), the parties submit the foregoing joint status report:

1. On September 1, 2020, the parties submitted a Joint Status Report in which they conveyed to the Court that counsel for Mr. Wyllie had supplied the government with a detailed written, and oral, overview of the medical events and conditions Mr. Wyllie has encountered and coped with since August 2018, as well as additional treating physician documentation detailing such serious and ongoing medical conditions. *See* Dkt. 62, ¶ 1.

2. Additionally, and in light of Mr. Wyllie’s serious and ongoing medical conditions, Pretrial Services submitted a report recommending that Mr. Wyllie’s conditions of release be modified to remove Condition 7a requiring Pretrial Services Supervision. *See* Dkt. 64. Neither the government nor Mr. Wyllie objected to this modification, and the Court adopted it on November 16, 2020. Dkt. 65.

3. On September 2, 2020, the Court ordered the parties by November 30, 2020 to “file a status report: (1) addressing what work remains before they will be in a position to determine how this case will proceed; (2) stating whether the 12/7/2020 status hearing should be rescheduled;

and (3) if the answer to (2) is yes, whether time may be excluded.” Dkt. 63. The Court also set a status hearing date for December 7, 2020. *Id.*

4. In preparation for this Joint Status Report, the parties once again met and conferred via email and by phone to address the Court’s inquiry and prepare the status report. While the parties are not yet in a position to determine how this case will proceed, the parties are committed to continuing their dialogue about what work remains before they will be in a position to determine how this case will proceed.

5. In light of the parties’ conference, the continued information sharing and commitment to engage in further dialogue, the parties request that the Court strike the December 7, 2020 status hearing date, and reset it until a date during the week of March 8, 2021. At that time, the parties will be better positioned to address the Court’s inquiry as to how this case will proceed.

6. The parties agree to the exclusion of time through the next status hearing date in March 2021, in the interest of justice, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).
