Dear Mr. Kraft:

Thank you for writing to Paris Police Department with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

On March 14, 2022 you requested to receive a copy of all videos, audios, and reports on case number 20-0252. You indicated it might have something to do with custodial employee sexual misconduct allegations.

Your request is granted in part and denied in part. Report number 20-0252 is included. However, it has been redacted of private information according to FOIA under section 7(1)(b) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b) (West 210), as amended by Public Acts 97-333, effective August 12, 2011; 97-385, effective August 15, 2011; 97-452, effective August 19, 2011. Section 2(c-5) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/2(c-5) (West 2010), as amended by Public act 97-579, effective August 26, 2011) defines "private information" as:

[u]nique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home addresses and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person.

Mission Statement

In order to protect life, property, and to prevent crime, we will provide service with understanding and compassion, build a culture of honor and integrity, and provide law enforcement with vision.

In addition, report number 20-0252 has been redacted according to FOIA under section 7(1)(c) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) (West 2016) as it pertains to dates of birth, *See e.g.*, Ill. Att’y Gen. Pub. Acc. Op. No. 16-009, issued November 7, 2016, at 12, and victims’ names and identifying information *See, e.g.*, Ill. Att’y Gen. PAC Req. Rev. Ltr. 37628, issued April 25, 2016 at 3.

Section 7(1)(c) exempts from inspection and copying [p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information. An “unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is the “disclosure of information that is highly personal objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.”
5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) (West 2016).

Furthermore, the video/audio interviews pertaining to report 20-0252 have been excluded as Paris Police Department does not have the equipment or technology necessary to redact the victims’ names and identifying information from the recorded interviews. The victims’ names and identifying information is exempt according to FOIA under section 7(1)(c) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) (West 2016) as it pertains to victims’ names and identifying information *See, e.g.*, Ill. Att’y Gen. PAC Req. Rev. Ltr. 37628, issued April 25, 2016 at 3. The disclosure of the victims’ names and personal information via the recorded interviews would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The individual’s right to privacy outweighs the general public’s interest in seeing and /or hearing personal identifying information.



In January 2020, I (Detective Hutson) was made aware of an internal investigation that had taken place at the Edgar Co Jail. Detective Lewsader had discovered a series of interviews in the course of another investigation. He indicated to me that upon viewing them it was evident that an investigation into a correctional officer named "Mark" was being investigated for a combination of supplying contraband and sexual contact with female inmates. I knew from my employment as a police officer that the only correctional employee to have ever worked at the Edgar Co Jail was Mark C. Holloway (DOB [REDACTED])

I first spoke with Cody W. Sanders by telephone. I was aware that Sanders was previously a 911 dispatcher at the Edgar Co jail. I knew he was predominantly on duty on the night shift thru the hours of 12am thru 8am. The schedule mirrored that of the correctional officer on duty which was usually Holloway. I asked him what he may know about inappropriate acts or conduct that may have occurred at the jail during his employment there involving Holloway and female inmates. Sanders indicated to me he believed they had occurred but had not actually seen so. He advised me that on 12-20-2016 he had reported to work for his shift as did Holloway. He indicated sometime during the shift Holloway had exited the building to take a "smoke break" and then a short time later after returning inside Holloway had been sequestered to the interview room by Deputy Burgin. He advised he believed Holloway was asked to resign his employment at that time which he did.

I then watched the videos that had been provided to me by Detective Lewsader. They included six different interviews with five separate women. I viewed the interviews as they were listed in order not necessarily chronologically.

The first interview was time stamped 5-29-2016 and labeled the female as [REDACTED]. The interview was conducted by Deputy Burgin. Ransom did indicate that Holloway had passed notes amongst female and male inmates but did not provide any other information. I then viewed a second interview with [REDACTED] conducted by Deputy Burgin. She then indicates that she was told by [REDACTED] that she had had "sex" with "Mark" on the stairs and in a patrol car. She also indicated that she had been told he had also had "sex" with [REDACTED]

The second person interviewed a female identified as [REDACTED]. The interview is date stamped 5-19-2016. She attempted to discuss things involved in her criminal case for a large portion of the interview. She too indicates she too has heard [REDACTED] had "sex" in a patrol car and "upstairs" in the jail. The information she provides appear to be hearsay and not first-hand knowledge.

The third female interviewed by Deputy Burgin was [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). The interview is date stamped 5-9-2016. He advises her she is in no trouble but is merely being questioned about some improprieties within the jail as he is doing an internal investigation. [REDACTED] then asks in an unsolicited statement "Is this about Mark?". She is then asked what she knows about the things he does while on duty as a correctional officer. She indicates she knows he has passed notes among female and male inmates. She indicates she is heard about the "[REDACTED] incident" which she then elaborates on. She states she has heard he got kissing her in the stairs.

The fourth interview is with a female labeled as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). The interview is date stamped 6-4-2020. [REDACTED] is the female interviewed who is not in the custody of the jail evident by her work uniform. [REDACTED] (now [REDACTED]) indicates during a period in 2015 when she was in jail she was housed in the "bullpen" with [REDACTED]. The bullpen is a large caged cell block that is centrally located in the jail. It is in the main level other than a few steps at the entrance. The cell block then consists of individual cells with it. The exterior is constructed of flat metal with a walkway around it's perimeter that permits viewing and openings. She indicates in the interview that during the period in which she

was incarcerated she was provided cigarettes by Holloway while in the jail. She indicates that she told Holloway that he "smelled good" so he gave them to her for the compliment. She is asked if any contact that would be sexual in nature occurred and she advised she had been "kissed" by Holloway. She describes an occurrence where he "gets her out" and they began kissing near the pop machine and side entrance to the kitchen area. She indicated he had provided her with prescription medication with that being an extra dose of her prescription of Xanax at her request or an instance where she had one of Potter's. She even described an instance where she dropped one of the pills. She indicated the pill fell thru the bars so she asked Holloway to assist in located it and he knelt to the ground and tried to help find it to no avail. She too indicates he helped pass notes among inmates. She then states Mark "Is a pig! He's a dog!" and is asked why she says that. She then states "because of what he has done with me and other people."

The fifth interview is with a female identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). The interview is date stamped 5-11-2016. [REDACTED] is advised at the beginning of the conversation that an investigation is taking place about conduct of "Mark Holloway" while in the jail. [REDACTED] seems surprised after being told so. She first displays a surprised look by the widening of her eyelids and then the use of her hands to conceal her face. She is advised that information has been gathered that she has first-hand knowledge of inappropriate conduct by Holloway. She then states "How do you know? and there's a lot of stuff." She then advises that she last had sexual intercourse with Holloway in between April 2015-July 2015, she is unsure of the exact day. She indicated the act took place in the "bullpen" thru the "bars". She then states "we messed around, he fingered me and all kind of stuff." She then pauses and shows sympathy for Holloway and questions whether he would get in trouble by the information she provides. She is then asked if they "made out" thru the bars and she states "Yeah, a bunch, almost every night." She is asked if anything else inappropriate occurred in the jail and she states no. She did advise she had to be transported to Marshall, IL for jail or court proceedings. She advised Holloway had transported her and suggested they "pull over" insinuating to have intercourse or engage in another type of sexual behavior. She states that he does not but that they did "make out" without any more elaboration. She then states she did not have she did have intercourse with him, they just "fooled around a little bit." She is then asked about another sex act and she states "I gave him head once" and confirms the act took place "thru the bars". She is presumably indicating the act of fellatio occurred by the slang used in the statement. She advises he would wake her up at night while the other females would be sleeping. She advised that nothing sexual in nature had occurred during her current stay in jail however he had tried to wake her up the night prior to the interview.

I then made contact with John M. Ramsey who I knew to be a former correctional officer and at a time hold the title of jail administrator. Ramsey was very cooperative in what limited knowledge he had. He indicated that the conduct was suspected and investigated. He believed it had been completed and prosecution had been sought. He indicated he wanted Holloway fired and/or removed from his position. He had hoped he may face criminal charges as well. He indicated to be that he thought approximately six months prior to Holloway's separation from the Sheriff's department that he had been interviewed about the alleged misconduct that may have included providing contraband to inmates and even inappropriate sexual conduct. He could not provide a determination of how that went just that he thought it occurred in the interview room of the jail and would be recorded. He then advised he knew he was interview on his final night of work at the jail. He then described an event where Holloway was essentially caught in the act of retrieving a cup of tobacco that had been left outside the jail for and inmate. The plan had been foiled by deputies after they discovered the suspicious cup after a light snowfall and later surveilled it.

I then made contact with contact via phone with [REDACTED] now known as [REDACTED]. I determined that since over three years had passed I would try to re-interview any victims or witnesses I could locate. She had indicated being kissed by Holloway in the initial interview as well as receiving controlled substances from him. She re-affirms that she was in jail for approximately 60 days during the time I was asking about. She also advises me she had spoken to deputy Burgin some time ago about the incident. I simply asked her about Holloway's conduct during that time in relation to things that were inappropriate in nature. She indicated she had told him how he smelled goo and in return he had given her cigarettes. She then re-told me how he had gotten her out and kissed her. She indicated to be surprised or taken back the first time but reciprocated the act. He then led her to the rear wall of the "bullpen" where sexual intercourse took place. She indicated this took place on two occasions. I inquired if he brought or wore a condom prior to the act. She indicated he had not at which time I inquired if he had ejaculated inside of her. She seemed unsure of how to answer the question so I asked if he had stopped and ejaculated on the floor. She indicated he had not and would have done so have inside her. She told me that during her time in jail during her incarceration Holloway gave her cigarettes, Klonopin (controlled substance) and the use of a cell phone. I asked her where he would have gotten the controlled substance and she advised he had taken them from an inmate who was no longer in custody but had left them behind. She indicated he also allowed her to use his cell phone which she used to get on Facebook and message people all while in her cell. I asked if any other inmate was in there during the times sex took place. She indicated [REDACTED] was and she was unsure if she knew. I then asked if she knew of any other female who had had sexual interactions with Holloway. She indicates she heard he had some kind of relationship with a [REDACTED] and "that [REDACTED]". She was very emphatic that she believed some type of relationship was occurring between Holloway and [REDACTED] (referring to [REDACTED]). She indicated they exhibited signs that were not normal of two people in passing let alone an inmate and guard.

I was unable to talk to [REDACTED] for the purposes of the investigation due to the fact that she is now deceased. I did speak with [REDACTED] as their names had been provided in the interviews as possible witnesses. [REDACTED] told me that she was in jail when [REDACTED] was and thought she had heard kissing between [REDACTED] and Holloway once. She told me she did not have any direct knowledge of other sexual contact between the two. I was not able to speak with [REDACTED] at the time of the investigation due to her being hospitalized.

A warrant for the arrest of Holloway is requested for the offense of Custodial Sexual Misconduct, Official Misconduct and Bringing Contraband into a Penal Institution.
