RESOLUTION TO CUSTOM FARM SHELBY COUNTY FARM

WHEREAS, Shelby County owns farmland known as "The Shelby County Farm;"

WHEREAS, Shelby County, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1005(3), has the power "to make all contracts and do all other acts in relation to the property and concerns of the county necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers;"

WHEREAS, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/1005(1), one of a County's corporate powers is "to purchase and hold the real and personal estate necessary for the uses of the county;" and "to sell and convey...any...personal estate owned by the county;"

WHEREAS, Stuart Fox has agreed to farm the Shelby County Farm, subject to the conditions outlined in the Custom Farm Agreement dated April 14, 2022;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Custom Farming Agreement, Shelby County will receive 100% of crop proceeds in exchange for \$1.00 payable to Stuart Fox as compensation for services rendered;

BE IT RESOLVED, that Shelby County agrees to enter into the Custom Farming Agreement, dated April 14, 2022, with Stuart Fox as the Custom Operator for the 2022 farming season.
