## NARRATIVE

Arrested, booked, and transported to the WCADF for charges of Aggravated DUI (625 ILCS 5/11-501(D)1(G)), DUI (625 ILCS 5/11-501A2), DWLR (625 ILCS 5/6-303), Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle (625 ILCS 5/3-707A), Improper Lighting (625 ILCS 5/12-201B), and Improper Lane Usage (625 ILCS 5/11-709A) (X2) was A/ Contreras, Angel. He is to appear at the WCCH at a TBD date and time. At 0420 hours, Contreras made one (1) phone call, at his request, while in the JPD lockup.

Incident captured on JPD Squad #0687 dash camera and BWC.

On the above date and time, I, Officer Macejak #174 was stationary near the intersection of Jefferson Street and Raynor Avenue, when I observed a gray 2007 Honda Ridgeline, Illinois Registration [REDACTED] VIN #2HJYK16417H530413, travel Northbound on Raynor Avenue without any of its lights illuminated. Upon catching up to the vehicle, and while behind the Honda, I observed the vehicle drive over the marked lane divider of left turn lane with both the front and rear driver side tires, as it approached the intersection of Raynor Avenue and Western Avenue. The Honda turned right, traveling Eastbound on Western Avenue after making a wide turn. The vehicle traveled in both the Eastbound and Westbound lanes of traffic, with the center of the vehicle traveling over the marked double yellow lane lines for several feet. I activated the emergency lights on my fully marked patrol vehicle near the intersection of Western Avenue and Wilcox Street. When the driver of the vehicle curbed the Honda, he struck and drove up the curb with his front passenger tire.

Upon walking up to the Honda, I requested the driver and sole occupant, later identified as A/ Contreras, Angel, to provide me with his driver's license and valid proof of insurance. Contreras related that his driver's license was Revoked, but that he had insurance for the vehicle. Contreras began looking for his identification and it took him several seconds to locate his Illinois State Identification Card. During this time, I questioned about his Revoked status. He thumbed through several cards before he provided me with his ID. When I asked Contreras if he knew why I was stopping him, he related he did not. I explained the reasons for the stop. Contreras then asked "Am I F'ed?" I asked him what he meant, he said "I'm just being honest." While speaking to Contreras I observed his eyes to be bloodshot and glassy, and his movements to be slow and deliberate. He appeared lethargic and had slurred speech.

Officer Janich #304 arrived on scene.

I requested Contreras to exit the Honda and he complied. After exiting the vehicle, I observed what appeared to be a small amount of dried vomit on the back of his right pant leg. When asked about it, Contreras denied having anything on his pants. I also observed that his collared shirt was untucked, despite the fact that he was wearing a suit jacket. I questioned Contreras where he was coming from, and he had difficulty explaining that it was a semi-formal event at the Clarion Hotel. When I asked him how much he had to drink, Contreras indicated that he was "just trying to go home." When further questioned if he had anything to drink, Contreras stood with a long pause and refused to provide a direct answer. He indicated that he "knew every officer around town," and asked if we could "accompany him home." Contreras was again provided with an opportunity to locate his proof of insurance.

Upon running Contreras' information through a LEADS inquiry, he returned with a Revoked Illinois Driver's License. His driver's license was Revoked on 02/06/2016 for 6-206A6. Upon reviewing his driver's abstract, I observed that he had a DUI conviction in the state of Indiana, which caused the Revocation.

When I returned to speak with Contreras, I observed that he and Officer Janich were reviewing something on Contreras' cell phone. Officer Janich advised that the document Contreras was displaying was only a notification of payment of insurance and not a proof of insurance. He was then provided a further period of time to locate the proof. When I again questioned Contreras how much he had to drink tonight, he related "Four drinks, at the end of the night, and I shouldn't of had that." "Literally at the end, end... I shouldn't have drank, I should have gone home." When I asked him if he should be driving while Revoked for DUI, and after having had a few drinks, he related "I know, I'm asking for the biggest favor." While speaking to Contreras, he repeatedly inched closer to me, and I had to back up multiple times. I offered Contreras to perform SFSTs several times, and he refused to provide an answer. He pleaded with me multiple times to allow him to go home, or to follow him home.

At 0242 hours Contreras was placed into custody for DUI. He was put into double locked handcuffs, which were checked for proper fit, and placed into the rear of my patrol vehicle. While seated in the back of my patrol vehicle, I observed Contreras to have the

strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. Contreras was transported to the Joliet Police Department lockup in order to be booked and processed.

The Honda was towed and impounded by Rendels Towing. The vehicle was later placed on seizure hold, LEADS #V22E3649. A Will County Seizure Notice was completed listing the Honda.

Contreras' 20 minute observation period began at 0305 hours, and he was read the Warning to Motorist while in the JPD lockup at 0306 hours. At 0326 hours, Contreras' observation period ended. He refused to provide a breath sample. Officer Beck #300 documented the refusal. At 0334 hours, Contreras was advised of his Miranda Rights, and he signed a Miranda Warning Form indicating that he understood them. Upon being questioned, he verbally admitted that he consumed four (4) Miller Lite beers between approximately 1600 hours and 0000 hours. Contreras related that at approximately 2200 hours he took his acid reflux medication. When asked if he was supposed to be drinking while on the medication, he advised that he was not. Contreras then advised that the combination of alcoholic beverages and the medication cause "fogginess" and "impairment."

Lt. Prochaska #32 approved Felony charges of Aggravated DUI (625 ILCS 5/11-501(D)1(G)) and Driving While License Revoked (625 ILCS 5/6-303).

Contreras was booked and transported to the WCADF. A copy of the Will County Seizure Notice was placed into his property.

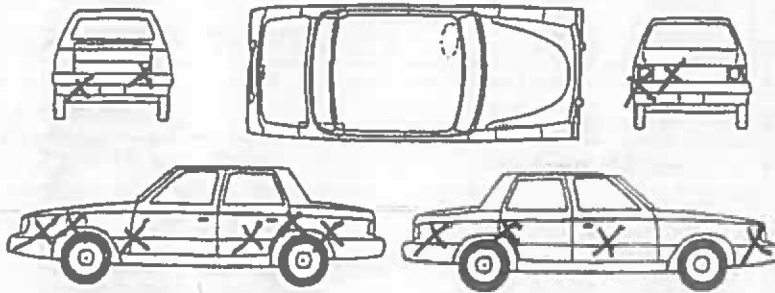
