ORIGINAL

Summary:

On 06/20/2022 at approximately 2128 hours, I Officer Davies #9486 was requested and dispatched to assist the Hebron Police Department on a traffic stop. Driver from the traffic stop was taken into custody by Hebron Police Department for driving under the influence. I preformed breath analysis operation. After my assistance was no longer needed I cleared and went back into service.

Narrative:

On 06/20/2022 at approximately 2128 hours, I Officer Davies #9486 was requested and dispatched to assist the Hebron Police Department on a traffic stop. Upon arrival I made contact with Officer Robert from the Hebron Police Department.

Officer Robert made contact with the driver (SHELTON, ROBERT) and conducted an investigation. I stood by as Officer Robert conducted Standardized Field Sobriety testing. Officer Robert requested that I assist in administering a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT). SHELTON provided a breath sample. The PBT gave a reading on .09.

Officer Robert determined that SHELTON was impaired and under the influence and placed SHELTON under arrest.

Once back at the Hebron Police Department I preformed breath analysis operation.

At approximately 2250 hours, I started the 20 minute observation period of SHELTON at which time he could not ingest or regurgitate anything.

At approximately 2310 hours, I ended the observation period. I completed entering the information into the breath analysis machine at the Hebron Police Department. I then asked SHELTON if he would submit to a breath test. SHELTON refused to submit to the breath test.

All information was turned over to Officer Robert.

I then cleared from the Hebron Police Department and went back into service.

This supplemental report is submitted reference a possible Official Misconduct charge that occurred during the processing of an arrest on 06-20-2022. During the listed dates and time, during the processing/bonding process I, Officer Christopher E. Robert #9606 was mace aware of the Arrestee calling and receiving legal advice from who Mr. Robert W. Shelton described as "his attorney" who was later discovered to be the village attorney for the Village of Hebron, [REDACTED] This information was relayed to Police Chief Donlea with Officer Schmoeller later making contact to the McHenry County States Attorney for further direction.

I then went 10-8 pending further investigation.

NARRATIVE

SUPPLEMENT

On 6/24/2022 at approximately 1430 hours I, Officer Schmoeller #9607 made contact with the McHenry County Assistant States Attorney's Office and spoke with Hunter Jones. I screened the case with him regarding the contact Shelton had with Village Attorney [REDACTED].

I briefed Hunter on the facts we believed Shelton violated of the Official Misconduct chapter in the Illinois Compiled Statutes. Chapter 720 of the ILCS Section 5/33-3 which reads: "A public officer or employee or special government agent commits misconduct when, in his official capacity or capacity as a special government agent, he or she commits any of the following acts . ." In either subsection 2 or 3, which states: (2) "knowingly performs an act which he knows is forbidden by law to perform," or (3) "with intent to obtain a personal advantage for himself or another, he performs an act in excess of his lawful authority."

I stressed to Hunter Jones that we felt Shelton either made the call to the Village Attorney for legal advise in a criminal matter, which he should've known was forbidden as stated in subsection #2, (potentially using Village funds for legal counsel) and/ or resources for a matter that does not involve Village business or, Shelton had intent to gain a personal advantage for himself, (in his position as Village President) thus, performing an act in excess of his lawful authority as stated in subsection #3. Hunter Jones went to his supervisor, Jim Newman who heard the same arguments. Felony charges ultimately were denied because of faulty bodycam video cutting off, squad car video not completely capturing the standardized field sobriety testing and poor audio recording of processing room conversation.
