On Tuesday, September 6, 2022, we received your FOIA request for Copy of everything on the VAC webpage that is "confusing, unclear, full of mistakes, and inaccurate information" as alleged ineligible commissioner Denise Williams stated during the September 1, 2022 special meeting.

In response, we have no documentation that is responsive to your request.

To the extent that you believe that this response is a denial of your request, you have the right to have a denial reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review by filing a lawsuit in the State Circuit Court. 5ILCS 140/11. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. 5ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
