ORDER

THIS CAUSE COMING TO BE HEARD, on pending pleadings including Respondent's Emergency **Motion to Compel Deposition of Lisa Sterba** and Kate Speed filed August 24, 2022, GAL's Petition for Setting of Final Fees and Costs filed on June 28, 2022, Respondent's Motion to Modify Parenting Time filed August 16, 2022, Respondent's Petition for Rule to Show Cause filed on June 2, 2022, Petitioner's Motion for Sanctions filed on February 3, 2022, Respondent's Motion to Compel Full Time Employment filed on December 21, 2021, Petitioner's Petition for Rule to Show Cause filed on November 1, 2021, Mark Ellis and Bernadette Garrison Barrett on behalf of Michael Edward Hastings and Timothy Daw and Ishita Saran on behalf of Kathleen Marilyn Hastings, all parties duly notified, and this due notice having been received and this Court advised fully of the premises:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Counsel for all parties are going to work on jointly scheduling depositions for Kathleen Hastings, Lisa Sterba, Katherine Speed, Bill Drew and Kevin Barnes.** The deposition deadline is continued until the time the depositions of Kathleen Hastings, Lisa Sterba, Kate Speed, Bill Drew and Kevin Barnes are completed. The depositions will occur on September 9th, 19th or other date via agreement.
2. Based on representation by Michael that it is not possible for him to invoice Kevron for funds/commissions owed, the payment of the Nancy Donlon's fees by separate order are being initially paid from the children's IUTMA accounts. However, the money shall be reimbursed to the IUTMA accounts by both parties the allocation reimbursement of which is reserved for determination by the arbitrator.
3. All pending petition for rule to show cause pleadings filed by both parties are denied.
4. Kate's Motion to Modify Parenting Time filed on or about August 16, 2022 is denied.
5. On the Court's own motion and in the best interest of the minor children, the right of first refusal is revoked and parenting time shall be remain in accordance with the prior Judgment with each party to be responsible for child care during their parenting time.

6. Michael's Motion for Sanctions and Injunctive Relief is denied.
