

1. No employee who has been convicted of a crime of domestic violence in accordance with Administrative Directive 03.02.108 or who has a current order of protection against him or her that prohibits possession or use of firearms or who has been an inpatient in a mental facility within the past 5 years, may possess, transport or receive a weapon or ammunition.
2. All firearms training shall be properly and adequately supervised by trained Firearms Range Instructors. All safety precautions shall be adhered to and enforced.
3. An employee shall direct his or her attention to the Range Master at all times.
4. Talking shall NOT be permitted on the firing line between shooters except when addressed by the Firearms Range Instructors.
5. No action shall be taken on the firing range without the prior command of the Firearms Range Instructor. A command shall NEVER be anticipated. Firing shall only be on the command of the Firearms Range Instructor.
6. Every weapon shall be treated as though it were loaded.
7. Immediately upon picking up a firearm, the cylinder or action shall be opened to ensure that it is unloaded, then double checked.
8. A firearm shall never be given to or taken from anyone unless the cylinder or action is open.
9. Firearms shall be loaded and unloaded ONLY when instructed by the Firearms Range Instructor and after a safe position is taken at the firing point.
10. Firearms shall be pointed down range at all times when not in the secured holster position. (Never point a weapon at a person or outside the range boundaries.)
11. All handguns shall be strapped in at all times, except while in the process of drawing and firing.
12. A handgun shall never be drawn from the holster or re-holstered with the finger in the trigger guard or on the trigger.
13. The finger shall remain outside of the trigger guard unless actually engaging the target.
14. The muzzle of a firearm shall never touch the ground.
15. In case of a misfire or hang-fire with the revolver, the firearm shall continue to be pointed downrange at least 10 seconds before opening the cylinder or action. In case of a misfire or hang-fire with a semi-automatic (rifle or handgun) the shooter shall attempt to clear the malfunction, fire his or her remaining rounds and notify a Range Instructor of the malfunction.
16. A weapon shall never be fired after a squib round (firearm malfunction in which a fired projectile does not have enough force behind it to exit the barrel) without first contacting a Firearms Range Instructor who shall unload and check the barrel for obstructions.
17. Never move in front of the line of fire until the firing line has been cleared and the commands "go forward" or "the line is clear" has been given.
18. Dry firing on the range shall be supervised by a Firearms Range Instructor.
19. No tobacco products shall be permitted at the range.
20. Individuals who appear to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol or who have the odor of drugs or alcohol on or about their persons shall not be allowed entrance to the range and shall be referred for reasonable suspicion testing.






