Dear Mr. Freeman, on September 3, 2024, the office of the Illinois Attorney General issues a binding opinion finding that the Village of Dolton (Village Board) "violated the OMA (Open meetings Act) by failing to make its June 3, 2024 and July 1, 2024 and open to the public," and directed the Village board "to take immediate an appropriate action to comply with this opinion by taking measures to make all future meetings convenient and open to the public, including holding meetings at a location with enough space to be reasonably accessible and configuring the meeting set-up to accommodate the Public."

The Next regular meeting of the Village Board is scheduled for Monday, October 7, 2024. This is the request that you make and direct adequate arrangements to ensure that our meeting room is open and freely accessible with provisions for over flow and standing areas, if necessary in order to accommodate members of the public.

You may obtain a copy of the Attorney General's opinion and directive from the Clerk.
