## **ORDER**

This cause coming to be heard on Plaintiffs' Motion for entry of a Temporary Restraining Order, Defendants' Motion for Rule 137 Sanctions and Plaintiffs' Motion to Drop Trustee Stanley Brown, all parties present through Counsel, the Court being fully advised, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. Plaintiffs' motion to drop Trustee Stanley Brown as a Plaintiff is not objected to by Defendants and therefore is granted. Trustee Stanley Brown is hereby stricken as a Plaintiff in this matter.
- 2. Plaintiff's motion for entry of a temporary restraining order is denied for failure to file verified pleadings.
- 3. Plaintiff was allowed to proceed on the unverified motion for a temporary restraining order and for the reasons stated on the record, Plaintiffs' motion for entry of a temporary restraining order is denied.
- 4. Defendants' motion for Rule 137 sanctions is entered and continued. Plaintiffs shall file a response to the motion for sanctions on or before November 18, 2024.
- 5. Plaintiffs' oral motion for leave to file an amended pleading is granted. Plaintiffs shall file their amended pleading on or before November 1, 2024.

- 6. Defendants shall file their responsive pleading to the amended complaint on or before December 6, 2024.
- 7. The Dolton Park District is hereby dismissed from this lawsuit.
- 8. The meetings of the Dolton Board of Trustees shall continue to occur at the Dolton Park District, with its approval, and in accordance with the Attorney General's Binding Opinion 24-010.
- 9. Trustee House is reminded that Mayor Henyard by law is to preside over Village Board meetings. In the future, Mayor Henyard is allowed a reasonable amount of time to appear at Village Board meetings to preside over same. If Mayor Henyard does not appear at future Village Board meetings, Trustee House may preside over the meetings as Mayor Pro Tem.
- 10. This matter is continued to **December 11, 2024** at **10:30** am via zoom for status on the pleadings.
