

The Champaign County Veterans' Assistance Commission is a resource for the nearly 10,000 veterans in Champaign County. By increasing the Public Safety Sales Tax, the County can provide additional funding to the Commission and our Veterans.

The referendum question on the ballot on November 5, 2024 is asking whether to increase the Public Safety Sales Tax a quarter of a cent. Currently, it is 25 CENTS for every \$100 spent, if the referendum passes, it would be 50 CENTS for every \$100 dollars spent in Champaign County. The referendum question will be on your ballot November 5th.

The Public Safety Sales Tax DOES NOT apply to groceries, titled or registered property (e.g. cars, trucks, farm equipment, boats, motorcycles, trailers), prescription and non-prescription medicines, medical appliances, and insulin.
